12. DELETED

13. TEMPORARY SERVICE

1. Consumers requiring electric service on a temporary basis shall be required by Cooperative to pay all the costs for connection and disconnection incidental to the supplying and removing of service. This rule applies to circuses, carnivals, temporary construction, tent meetings, saw mills, oil wells, coal mines, trailers and the like.

2. A deposit may be required to cover estimated use of electricity. Both fees are to be paid in advance. At the termination of service any balance remaining of the deposit for use of electricity will be refunded.

3. Service billing for less than 30 days shall be billed on the appropriate rate schedule and shall not be prorated.

4. The monthly minimum bill shall not be less than \$3.00.

14. SERVICE TO CONSUMERS WHICH MAY BE OF SHORT DURATION

In cases of service to power the pumping of oil wells, the operation of oil fields, and any and all other types of consumer services which may be of short duration, the Cooperative must and shall protect its investments on same in the following manner:

The consumer, at the time of application is made for such service shall pay a deposit to the Cooperative, in each instance, an amount equal to the cost of construction

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to small commercial, industrial, public buildings, and three-phase farm service, including lighting, heating and power, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Seller.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase or three-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

MONTHLY RATE



Minimum Monthly Charges:

\$3.00 where 3 KVA or less of transformer capacity is required. Each consumer who requires more than 3 KVA of transformer capacity shall pay, in addition to the above minimum, 75¢ for each additional KVA or fraction thereof required. Where the minimum charge is increased in accordance with the terms of this section, additional energy therefor may be taken in accordance with the terms of the foregoing schedule.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT

The consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The measured demand will be adjusted to correct for consumers with 50 KW or more of measured demand to correct for average power factors lower than 85 per cent. Such adjustments will be made by increasing the measured demand 1 per cent for each 1 per cent by which the average power factor is less than 85 per cent lagging.

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

In case the rate under which the Seller purchases power at wholesale is adjusted in accordance with fuel cost adjustment provisions contained in the Seller's wholesale power contract, the charges per KWH in the applicable rate schedule shall be adjusted each month by the same amount per KWH as the cost adjustment per KWH in the Seller's wholesale power bill for the next preceding month.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:

1. The minimum monthly charge as specified in the contract for service.
2. A charge of \$.75 per KVA of installed transformer capacity.
3. A charge of \$25.00.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE FOR SEASONAL SERVICE:

Consumers requiring service only during certain seasons not exceeding 9 months per year may guarantee a minimum annual charge, in which case there shall be no minimum monthly charge. The minimum annual charge shall be sufficient to assure adequate compensation for the facilities installed to serve the Consumer, and in no event shall it be less than \$9.00 per KVA of installed transformer capacity or \$300.00 whichever is greater.

SERVICE PROVISIONS:

1. Delivery Point. If the service is furnished at secondary voltage, the delivery point shall be the metering point unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

If the service is furnished at Seller's primary line voltage, the delivery point shall be the point of attachment of Seller's primary line to Consumer's transformer structure unless otherwise specified in the contract for service. All wiring, pole lines and other electric equipment (except metering equipment) on the load side of the delivery point shall be owned and maintained by the Consumer.

- 2. Primary Service. If the service is furnished at primary distribution voltage, a discount of fifteen cents (\$.15) per KW shall apply to the demand charge, and if the minimum charge is based on transformer capacity, a discount of seven per cent (7%) shall apply to the minimum charge. However, the Seller shall have the option of metering at secondary voltage and adding the estimated transformer losses to the metered kilowatt demand and kilowatt hours.

The above rates are net, the gross rates being 5% higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid by the fifteenth of the month following the meter reading date, the gross rates shall apply.


