Schedule of Special Charges

- Sewer Deposit: The District requires a cash deposit of \$90.00 (ninety dollars) to secure payment of bills. Upon the payment of such deposit, the District shall issue to each customer a receipt of deposit, showing the name of the customer, the location of the premises occupied, and the date and amount of the deposit. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay required deposit. Interest will accrue on all deposits at the rate prescribed by law beginning on the date of deposit. Interest accrued will be refunded to the customer or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis. If interest is paid or credited to the customer's bill prior to twelve (12) months from the date of deposit. Upon termination of service, the deposit, along with any accrued interest, will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.
- 2. <u>Service Connection Charge:</u> A charge of \$15.00 shall be made for all service reconnections (water/sewer) made during the regular working hours, except that there shall be no connection charge made for service on the original installation of facilities. If service is reconnected other than during regular business working hours the charge shall be \$35.

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- 3. <u>Delinquent Service Charge:</u> A charge of \$15 shall be made for a trip to disconnect a delinquent account. A reconnection charge of \$15 shall be made if reconnected during regular working hours.
- 4. <u>Late Payment Penalty Charge</u>: A charge of 10% shall be added on each customer's unpaid water/sewer bill after the 20th of each month.
- 5. <u>Return Check:</u> A charge of \$25 shall be charged for any returned check received by the District.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- A. All connections to the sewer system of the District shall be made by and/or under the direction and supervision of District personnel. Each customer connecting to the sewer system of the District will be required to pay a connection charge which will not be in excess of an amount sufficient to enable the District to recoup the actual costs of making such connection.
- B. Water service may be discontinued by the District, upon 10 days' written notice (except that in the event of a violation under Item 5 below, water service may be terminated immediately), for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition of service relating to the sewer system, and especially for any of the following reasons:
 - 1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to any unusual or extraordinary use to be made of sewer facilities.
 - 2. Failure to report to the District additions to the property or fixtures to be served by or additional use to be made of sewer facilities.
 - 3. Connection of a storm water drain with the sewer system of the District or any other introduction of storm water into the sewer system.
 - 4. Placing or discharging into the sewer system any substances which will create a combustible, gaseous, explosive, or inflammable condition in said system, or discharging into said system any substances or objects which will not dissolve and which will thus cause an obstruction and clogging within said system, or placing or discharging of petroleum products into the sewer system.
 - 5. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, with reference to the continuation of sever service, water service shall be cut off without notice or shall be refused, provided the District shall Gotlfy ChK dud tomer or applicant immediately of the reasons Public Strike Clausion tinuance or refusal and the correction action to be taken by the applicant or customer before services can be restored.

- C. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the user's agreement unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.
- D. 1. Bills for sewer service (which shall be included on the water bill of each sewer customer) are due and payable at the office of the District, or to any designated agent, on the date of issue. The past due date shall be the 20th day of each month. A late payment charge will be added on each customer's unpaid bill after the 20th of each month.

2. All bills not paid on or before the past due date shall be deemed delinquent. When a bill has been delinquent for a period of five days, the District shall serve a customer a written final notice of said delinquency, and of the intent of the District to discontinue service five days after the date of such notice unless such bill is paid prior to the expiration of such five days. Under no circumstances shall service be terminated before twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original unpaid bill. If a delinquent bill is not paid within five days after the date of such final notice, the water/sewer supply to the customer may be discontinued without further notice, provided, however, if, prior to discontinuance of service, there is delivered to the District, or to its employee empowered to discontinue service, a written certification signed by a physician, a registered nurse, or a public health officer, that, in the opinion of

The undersigned CUSTOMER does hereby agree to purchase water from the WATER DISTRICT and to pay all initial installation and connection fees, together with all standard monthly charges which may be fixed by the Board of Commissioners of the SOUTH 641 WATER DISTRICT and/or Utility Regulator Commission for the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The CUSTOMER agrees to pay each consecutive monthly payment, at all appropriate rates, for water service, when due, and to further comply with, and be bound by, the provisions of the policies and/or amendments of the WATER DISTRICT together with such rules and regulations as may, from time to time, be adopted by the WATER DISTRICT.
