THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into this 15^{th} day of Nevember, 1984, by and between

. . . .

THE CITY OF BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY, a municipality located in Nelson County, Kentucky, hereinafter called "Seller", and

THE CITY OF BLOOMFIELD, KENTUCKY, situated in Nelson County, Kentucky, hereinafter called "Purchaser",

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties to this addendum are the same parties as set out in a certain agreement styled "Mater Purchase Contract" of date January 8, 1980, and whereas, the Seller is now desirous of amending a portion of the terms contained in the original contract, which is agreeable to the Purchaser under the conditions specified by this first addendum.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the Covenants and agreements hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree and do hereby amend those paragraphs and sections of the aforementioned agreement by the including of new paragraphs and/or section and/or changing in whole and/or in parts existing paragraphs and sections thereof, which contract shall from and after the effective date of changes therein, read as if contained in the original agreement:

Page 1, A. The Seller Agrees

1. (Quality and Quantity) To furnish the Purchaser, at the point of delivery hereinafter specified, during the term of this contract or any renewal or extension thereof, potable treated water meeting applicable purity standards of the Kentucky Department for Natural Resources and Environmental Protection, Division of Water (or other cognizant agency) in such quantity as may be required by the Purchaser (not to exceed 10,000,000 gallons per month or 120,000,000 gallons per year).

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PURSUANT TO 307 KAR 5:011, SECTION 2 (1)

2. (Point of Delivery and Pressure) That Water will be furnished at a reasonably constant pressure calculated at 30 lbs per sq. in. from an existing eight (8) inch main supply at a point located near the East Bardstown standpipe near the intersection of KY 162 and KY 62. If a greater pressure than that normally available at the point of delivery is required by the Purchaser, the cost of providing such greater pressure shall be borne by the Purchaser. Emergency failures of pressure or supply due to main supply line breaks, power failure, flood, fire, and use of water to fight fire, earthquake, or other catastrophe shall excuse the Seller from this provision for such reasonable period of time as may be necessary to restore service. The Seller shall not be responsible to provide for a rate of flow in excess of 235 gallons per minute, but Seller may increase the rate of flow on a temporary basis from time to time if it determines that such increase is feasible.

Page 2, B. The Purchaser Agrees

1. (Rates and Payment Date) To pay the Seller, not later than the fifteenth (15th) day of each month, for water delivered in accordance with the following schedule of rates:

a. \$2,400.00 for the first 3,000,000 gallons which amount shall also be the minimum rate per month.

b. \$0.80 per 1,000 gallons for all water in excess of 3,000,000 gallons but less than 9,000,000 gallons per month.

Page 4, C. It is further mutually agreed between the Seller and Purchaser as follows:

 (Term of Contract) That this contract shall extend for a term of fifty (50) years from date of initial billing scheduled for December 1, 1984, and thereafter may be renewed or extended for such term, or terms, as may be agreed upon by the Seller and Purchaser:
