RE: New Water Rate

Gentlemen:

On May 1, 1979, the City of Eddyville was obliged to increase water rates in an attempt to overcome a recurring yearly deficit in the operation and maintenance of the system. The rate for our largest user (over 100,000 gallons) is now \$.80 per M.

The City Council, in the regular meeting held on July 2, 1979, voted to establish the Fredonia rate as \$.80 per M for the first 2,800,000 gallons and \$1.50 per M for any excess effective July 1, 1979.

Please inform us when you can meet with us in order to formulate a new agreement.
