- 2. (Delivery of Water) That _____ days prior to the estimated date of completion of construction of the Purchaser's water supply distribution system, the Purchaser will notify the Seller in writing the date for the initial delivery of water.
- 3. (Water for Testing) When requested by the Purchaser the Seller will make available to the contractor at the point of delivery, or other point reasonably close thereto, water sufficient for testing, flushing, and trench filling the system of the Purchaser during construction, irrespective of whether the metering equipment has been installed at that time, at a

flat charge of $\frac{n/a}{}$ which will be paid by the contractor or, on his failure to pay, by the Purchaser.

- 4. (Failure to Deliver) That the Seller will, at all times, operate and maintain its system in an efficient manner and will take such action as may be necessary to furnish the Purchaser with quantities of water required by the Purchaser. Temporary or partial failures to deliver water shall be remedied with all possible dispatch. In the event of an extended shortage of water, or the supply of water available to the Seller is otherwise diminished over an extended period of time, the supply of water to Purchaser's consumers shall be reduced or diminished in the same ratio or proportion as the supply to Seller's consumers is reduced or diminished.
 - 5. (Modification of Contract) That the provisions of this contract pertaining to the schedule of rates to be paid by

(Miscellaneous) That the construction of the water supply distribution system by the Purchaser is being financed by a loan made or insured by, and/or a grant from, the United States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration of the United States Department of Agriculture, and the provisions hereof pertaining to the undertakings of the Purchaser are conditioned upon the approval, in writing, of the State Director of the Farmers Home Administration.
- 8. (Successor to the Purchaser) That in the event of any occurence rendering the Purchaser incapable of performing under this contract, any successor of the Purchaser, whether the result of legal process, assignment, or otherwise, shall succeed to the rights of the Purchaser hereunder.
- 9. It is agreed that all of the Purchasers rights and equities under this contract may be and the same are hereby pledged to the USDA, FmHA, as security for a loan FmHA proposes to make the Purchaser to finance the construction or extensions of a water system.
- 10. It is further agreed by and between the parties hereto that the City reserves the right to purchase any and all facilities, including service connections, and the right to provide water service to any and all customers of the District, which facilities and customers are located within a radius of two miles measuring north-eastwardly generally along Highway 159 and five miles southward, measuring generally along Highway 27, all such measurements to be taken from the present limits of the City of Facilities legally annexed the foregoing described area, or either of such two segments, into the city proper.
