ORDINANCE 93-___: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WATER AND SEWER RATES FOR THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF MARION, KENTUCKY.

Be it ordained by the City of Marion, Kentucky as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 50.02 of the Marion Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:
