

CITY OF TOMPKINSVILLE  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 91 \_\_\_\_\_

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE EXISTING RATES FOR THE USE OF AND THE SERVICES BY THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM OF TOMPKINSVILLE.

SECTION ONE: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance that is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, then, such portion, or portions, shall be deemed as separate, distinct and independent provisions and such holdings shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION TWO: Any previous ordinance or resolution in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall become effective after passage, approval and publication as required by the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and other appropriate law.

SECTION FOUR: THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TOMPKINSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: WATER AND SEWER RATES.

The rates for all customers for all water and sewer services furnished by the City of Tompkinsville, Kentucky, (except the Monroe County Water District) are as follows:

a) MONTHLY RATES.

Subject to a minimum monthly water rate of \$8.16, for which each water customer shall be entitled to 2,000 gallons (or less) of water in each month, the following metered charges shall be made:

<u>NUMBER OF GALLONS OF WATER PER MONTH</u>	<u>MONTHLY CHARGE PER 1,000 GALLONS</u>
First 2,000 gallons or less	\$8.16(minimum monthly charge)
Next 8,000 gallons	\$2.04
Next 90,000 gallons	\$1.54
All over 100,000 gallons	\$1.29

B) MONTHLY SEWER RATES

Rates or charges for sewer service shall be based insofar as possible upon the quantity of water supplied to the respective buildings or premises, and shall be in an amount equal to 80% of the amount on the water bill.
