Whereas, the Purchaser is organized and established under the provisions of KILLS ESTION 9 (1) 65.810 of the code of N/A for the purpose of constructing and BCU operating a water supply distribution this purpose, the Purchaser will require a supply of the commission treated water and
Whereas, the Seller owns and operates a water supply distribution system with a capacity currently capable of serving the present customers of the Seller's system and the estimated number of water users to be served by the said Purchaser as shown in the plans of the system now on file in the office of the Purchaser, and
Whereas, by Resolution. No.623-02 enacted on the 23rd day of June, 1997,
By the seller, the sale of water to the Purchaser in accordance with the provision of the
said Contract was approved, and the execution of this contract carrying out the said
Resolution by the Mayor, and attested by the secretary, was duly authorized, and
Whereas, by Motion of the Commissioner of the Purchaser, enacted on the
Day of, 1997, the purchase of water from the Seller in
Accordance with the terms set forth in the said Motion was approved, and the
Execution of this contract by the Chairman, and attested by the Secretary was duly authorized;
Now, therefore_in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual agreements hereinafter set forth,

A. The Seller Agrees:

1. (Quality and Quantity) To furnish the Purchaser at the point of delivery hereinafter specified, during the term of this contract or any renewal or extension thereof, potable treated water meeting applicable purity standards of the Kentucky Division of Water in such quantity as may be required by the Purchaser not to exceed 300,000 gallons per month. 2. (Point of Delivery and Pressure) That water will be furnished at a reasonably from an existing 8 inch main constant pressure calculated at ___60 PS1 supply at a point located Index Arca. If a greater pressure than that normally available at the point of delivery is required by the SERVICE COMMISSION OF KENTUCKY Purchaser, the cost of providing such greater pressure shall be borne by the Purchaser. **EFFECTIVE** Emergency failures of pressure or supply due to main supply line breaks, power failure, flood, fire and use of water to fight fire, earthquake or other catastrophe shall excuse the APR 09 1999 Seller from this provision for such reasonable period of time as may be necessary to restore service. PURSUANT TO SOF KAR 5011. SECTION 9(1) 3. (Metering Equipment) To furnish, install, operate, and maintain at its own expense at point of delivery, the necessary metering equipment, including a meter house. or pit, and required devices of standard type for properly measuring the quantity of water to the course of delivered to the Purchaser and to calibrate such metering equipment whenever requested by the Purchaser but not more frequently than once every twelve (12) months. A meter registering not more than two percent (2%) above or below the test result shall be deemed to be accurate. The previous readings of any meter disclosed by test to be inaccurate shall be corrected for the 30 Days previous to such test in accordance with the percentage of inaccuracy found by such tests. If any meter fails to register for any period, the amount of water furnished during each period shall be deemed to be the amount of water delivered in the corresponding period immediately prior to the failure, unless Seller and Purchaser shall agree upon a different amount. The metering equipment shall be An appropriate official of the Purchaser at all reasonable times shall have access to the meter for the purpose of verifying its readings. 4. (Billing Procedure) To furnish the Purchaser at the above address not later day of each month, with an itemized statement of the amount of

4. (Failure to Deliver) That the Seller will, at all times, operate and maintain its system in an efficient manner and will take such action as may be necessary to furnish the

on his failure to pay, by the Purchaser.

3. (Water for Testing) When requested by the Purchaser, the Seller will make available to the contractor at the point of delivery, or other point reasonably close thereto, water sufficient for testing, flushing, and trench filling the system of the Purchaser during construction, irrespective of whether the metering equipment has been installed at the time, at a flat charge of \$2.10 per 1,000 gallons, which will be paid by the contractor or.

Purchaser with quantities of water required by the Purchaser. Temporary or partial failures to deliver water shall be remedied with all possible dispatch. In the event of an extended shortage of water, or the supply of water available to the seller is otherwise diminished over an extended period of time, the supply of water to Purchaser's consumers shall be reduced or diminished before the supply to Seller's consumers is reduced or diminished.

- 5. (Modification of Contract) That the provisions of this contract pertaining to the schedule of rates to be paid by the Purchaser for water delivered are subject to modification as needed. Any increase or decrease in rates shall be based on a demonstrable increase or decrease in the costs of performance hereunder, including increased capitalization of the Seller's system. Other provisions of this contract may be modified or altered by mutual agreement.
- 6. (Regulatory Agencies) That this contract is subject to such rules, regulations, or laws as may be applicable to similar agreements in this State and the Seller and Purchaser will collaborate in obtaining such permits, certificates, or the like, as may be required to comply therewith.
- 7. (Miscellaneous) That the construction of the water supply distribution system by the Purchaser is being financed by a loan made or insured by, and/or a grant from, the United States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration of the United States Department of Agriculture, and the provisions hereof pertaining to the undertakings of the Purchaser are conditioned upon the approval, in writing, of the State Director of the Farmers Home Administration.
- 8. (Successor to the Purchaser) That in the event of any occurrence rendering the Purchaser incapable of performing under this contract, any successor of the Purchaser, whether the legal process, assignment, or otherwise, shall succeed to the rights of the Purchaser hereunder.
