RATES AND CHARGES

East Clark County Water District

\$1.62 per 100 cubic feet plus Kentucky River Authority Fee of \$0.10 per 100 cubic feet.

A Water Purchase Contract between the City of Winchester (by and through its Winchester Municipal Utilities Commission) and the East Clark County Water District, entered into on the 15th day of July 1999 is on file at the Kentucky Public Service Commission. The PSC accepted the contract and made it effective on January 20, 2000. The Winchester Municipal Utilities and the City of Winchester Commissions approved and entered into Contract Amendment Number 2 and Memorandum of Settlement with East Clark County Water District on June 6, 2006 (both documents are on file at the Kentucky Public Service Commission). The PSC accepted the Contract Amendment Number 2 and Memorandum of Settlement and made them effective on August 16, 2006. (See PSC Case No. 2005-00322.)

The rate change above is for the increase in the Kentucky River Authority Fee. The rate reflects a change in the Kentucky River Authority Fee from \$0.05 per 100 cubic feet to \$0.10 per 100 cubic feet. The Kentucky River Authority effective April 1, 2008, increased its Tier II withdrawal fee from \$0.038 per 1,000 gallons (0.0284 per 100 cubic feet) to \$0.082 per 1,000 gallons (0.0613 per 100 cubic feet). Because Winchester Municipal Utilities withdraws a portion of its water from Tier I sources, its blended rate merely increased slightly more than \$0.10 per 100 cubic feet.
