Electric service for other than standard residential, farm, and small commercial use shall be provided under conditions that will not seriously jeopardize the objective of the Cooperative of providing electric service for normal service usage. Services classified under this application include advertisement signs, barns, water wells, resort cottages (a resort cottage is defined as a residence not lived in as a permanent residence for at least nine months of the year), farms which are not regularly operated as such, and farm installations whose tenure of service may be considered indefinite.

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Service to consumers falling under this category may be provided under the following conditions:

- 1. A contribution may be required prior to the extension of service.
- 2. Extension of electric facilities without contribution is limited to two primary poles. A contribution in aid of construction in the amount of \$150 per primary pole shall be required for that portion over two poles.
- 3. The consumer may be required to furnish acceptable surety of the contract, which may include surety endorsement, real estate mortgage, or advanced payment based on the minimum and tenure of the contract.
- B. The extension of service to subdivision developments in resort areas shall be furnished under the following conditions:
 - 1. The developer shall furnish a plat to the Cooperative for location of electric facilties and shall file a plat with the County Court Clerk identifying right-of-way easements granted to the electric utility.
 - 2. For each subdivision or section thereof to be provided with electric facilities, the Cooperative shall design and stake the line in such a manner as to most economically serve the development. The developer shall pay \$150 per primary pole required in excess of the first two poles installed in the initial development.
 - 3. The Cooperative shall make service available to applicants along the route of the extension by execution of a one-year continuous service contract at the basic monthly minimum.
 - 4. For a period of ten years after completion date of the extension, the Cooperative shall refund to the developer, \$130 for each Consumer of connected to the extension, but in no case shall the total amount of the refund exceed the amount paid the Cooperative.
