MINIMUM CHARGES

The minimum monthly charge under the above rate shall be \$2.00 where 5 kva or less transformer capacity is required. For members requiring more than 5 kva of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly charge shall be increased at the rate of .75 for each additional kva or fraction thereof required. Payment of the minimum charge shall entitle the member in all cases to the use of the number of kilowatt hours corresponding to the minimum charge in accordance with the foregoing rate.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, the gross rates being five per cent higher. In the event the current monthly bill is not paid within 15 days from the date of the bill, the gross rates shall apply.

(4) Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horse-power (10 H.P.) must be three-phase.

(5) Service under this schedule is limited to consumers whose load requirements can be met by transformers having a capacity not to exceed 25 kva. Consumers requiring more than 25 kva shall be served under an appropriate schedule for large power service.

Temporary Service:

(a) Temporary service shall be supplied in accordance with the foregoing rate except that there shall be an additional charge of \$2.00 for each kilowatt or fraction thereof of connected load for each month or fraction thereof that service is connected. Bills will not be prorated for a fractional part of a month.

(b) The consumer shall in addition pay the total cost of connecting and disconnecting the service less the value of materials returned to stock. The cooperative may require a deposit, in advance, of the full amount of the estimated bill for service including the cost of connection and disconnection.


The billing demand shall be the maximum average kilowatt load used by the Consumer for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

Power Factor

The Consumer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the power factor at the time of his maximum demand is less than 90%, the demand for billing purposes shall be the demand as indicated or recorded by the demand meter multiplied by 90% and divided by the percent power factor.




