RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are subject to change by the Water District Commissioners at any time, subject to approval by the Public Service Commission.

1. Meters will be read monthly between the 15th and 20th of each month.
2. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first of each month. Said bills will state that they are to be paid within ten days.
3. All meters will be located on the property to be served. If that is not practical, meters will be placed at/near the water main.
4. Complaints may be made to either Commissioner individually or to the Commission at the regular monthly meeting at 1:00 PM, on the first Monday of each month in the City-County Building, Scottsville, Kentucky.
5. Bills may be paid at, or mailed to the COUNTY TREASURER'S OFFICE, CITY-COUNTY BUILDING, SCOTTSVILLE, KENTUCKY 42164.
6. The principle place of business of the Water District will be the County Treasurer's Office, City-County Building, Scottsville, Kentucky 42164.
7. Bill adjustments due to leakage/meter inaccuracy:
 - a. Whenever a meter in service is found upon periodic test or customer complaint to be more than two percent (2%) fast or slow, the amount to be refunded or back billed by the District shall be based on the percentage of error as determined by the test. The period covered shall be one half (1/2) of the elapsed time since installation of the meter or the last periodic test but in no case shall exceed twelve (12) months.
 - b. In the event of loss of water through leakage equal to, or greater than one hundred percent (100%) of normal usage, consideration will be given to adjustment of the user's bill based on \$1.00 per 1,000 gallons above his normal average of the previous three months.
 - c. Faulty meters will be changed at no cost to the user. If the user requests a meter test and the meter is not faulty, a service charge of \$15.00 will be assessed.

8. Discontinuance of Service:

a. Service will be discontinued for non-compliance with Water District, State, or local rules, regulations or codes applying to such service. A reasonable effort will be made to persuade the customer to comply prior to giving written notice.

b. When a dangerous condition is found to exist service will be cut-off without notice and the customer notified immediately of the reason and corrective measures necessary before service will be restored.

c. Service will be terminated or refused, 15 days after written notice of intention, when the customer refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises for meter reading, maintenance or installation of service.

d. Service will not be provided to a customer whose service has been terminated because of non-payment of bills until the customer has paid such indebtedness. A new service will not be installed for an applicant who is indebted to the District until the indebtedness is paid.

e. Termination of service due to non-payment of bills will conform to the following procedure:

(1). A reasonable effort will be made to induce the customer to pay the amount in arrears.

(2).. The customer shall be given ten (10) days written notice, but the cut-off shall not be made before thirty (30) days after the mailing date of the original bill. The termination notice shall be exclusive of and separate from the original bill.

(3). If the amount in arrears is paid to the office or an individual empowered to cut-off the service prior to termination, then the cut-off shall not be made; or if a written certificate is filed, signed by a physician, a registered nurse or public health officer stating that, in their opinion, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the premises, service shall not be terminated until the affected resident can make other living arrangements; or until thirty (30) days elapse from the time of the District's notification in writing of the existence of local, state and federal programs providing for payment of utility bills under certain conditions, and of the offices to contact for such possible assistance.

(4). Requests for a partial payment plan to pay the amount in arrears will be considered on an individual basis.

§5). Any written notice for discontinuance of service will advise the customer of his rights under 807 ~~Kar 2:010(11)~~ and of his right to dispute the reasons for such discontinuance.

KAR 25:020 - Section 11

9. Extension of service:

A. Normal extensions: An extension of fifty (50) feet or less shall be made by the District to an existing distribution main without charge for an applicant who will contract to use the service for one (1) year or more and provide a guarantee for such service.

b. Other extensions:

(1). When an extension of the District's main to serve an applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than fifty (50) feet per applicant the District may require the cost of excessive footage, based on estimated cost per foot, be deposited with the District.

(2). An applicant, or group of applicants, may contract with a qualified contractor to have an extension constructed to serve them. Plans and materials will be approved by the District and installation performed under District supervision.

(3). An applicant desiring an extension to a proposed real estate ~~subdivision~~ subdivision may be required to pay the entire cost of the extension to and through the subdivision. Such applicant may contract with a qualified contractor to have the extension installed. Plans and materials shall be approved by the District and installation of the extension shall be subject to inspection and approval by the District. Upon approval, the extensions shall be dedicated to the District for operation and maintenance.

The cost of 50ft of the extension

(4). Each customer receiving service under (1), (2), (3) above or c below will be reimbursed as follows: Each year, for a refund period of the (10) years after completion, the District shall refund to the customer or customers in place for each additional customer connected directly to the extension during the year This refund shall not apply to laterals or extensions therefrom and in no case will refunds exceed the amount paid the District or cost of construction of an extension. No refunds will be made after the refund period.

c. Other arrangements for financing and constructing extensions may be made when practical. Such arrangements are subject to approval by the Utility Regulatory Commission of Kentucky.
