RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. PSC Regulations:** These Rules and Regulations are in addition to rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission. In cases of conflict, the PSC Regulations shall prevail. These Rules and Regulations are a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the District, and applies to all service received from the District whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application, or otherwise. A copy of this schedule, together with a copy of the District's Schedule of Rates and Charges, shall be kept open to inspection at the Office of the District.
- 2. Application for Service:** Each prospective customer desiring water service is required to sign the District's Standard Water Service Contract before service is supplied by the District. If service is desired on the same side of the road as the water main, the meter will be installed within five feet of the water main where practical. If service is desired on the opposite side of the road from the water main, the service line will be run under the road and the meter installed on private property adjacent to the highway right-of-way. A contribution in aid of construction as provided in the Schedule of Rates and Charges must be paid on all new connections to the existing water line. Applications for service connection installation will not be processed if the applicant is indebted to the District on a past due account, bad debt, or in any other fashion whatsoever. Extensions to the Utilities main lines shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12(2).

- 3. Billing:** Bills will be rendered monthly and shall be paid within fifteen days from date of bill at the Office of the District. Failure to receive a bill will not release the customer from payment obligations. Bills paid on or before the final date of payment shall be payable at the net rates, but thereafter the gross rates shall apply as provided in the Schedule of Rates and Charges. Should the final date for payment of the bill at the net rates fall on a Sunday or holiday, the business day next following the final date will be held as a day of grace for delivery of payment.
- 4. Discontinuance of Service by District:** Should bills not be paid as outlined in 3 above, the District may at any time subsequent to twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill, and upon at least forty-eight (48) hours written notice, discontinue service. Such termination notice shall be exclusive of the original bill. If, prior to discontinuance of service there is delivered to the District's Office payment of the amount in arrears, then discontinuance of service shall not be made, or as to residential services when a written certificate is filed, signed by a

physician, a registered nurse or a public health officer stating that in the opinion of the person making the certification, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, service shall not be discontinued until the (10) days elapse from the time of the District's notification. The District may refuse to connect or may discontinue service for the violation of any of its Rules and Regulations, or for violation of any of the provisions of the Schedules of Rates and Charges, or of the customer service contract. The District may discontinue service to a customer for the theft of water or the appearance of water theft devices on the customer's premises. The District shall not be required to restore service until the customer has complied with all Rules and Regulations of the Commission and the District has been reimbursed for the estimated amount of the service rendered and for any cost incurred by reason of the fraudulent use. All discontinuance of services is subject to the Notice Requirements of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.

5. Deposit. A deposit or suitable guarantee equal to approximately twice the average monthly water bill may be required of any customer before water service is supplied. The District may, at its option, return the deposit plus six percent (6%) annual interest to the customer after one year. Upon termination of service, deposit and interest may be applied by the District against any unpaid bills of the customer, and if any balance remains after such application is made, said balance shall be refunded to the customer. Upon demand by the customer, the District will pay or credit bill of customer with interest at the end of each year from date of deposit, providing demand is made by the customer for payment of credit. In the absence of such demand, interest continues to run, but the District may voluntarily credit the bill with interest.

6. Point of Delivery. The point of delivery is the point where the meter is located on the customer's premises. All water lines, plumbing, and equipment beyond the meter shall be installed and maintained by the customer.

7. Customer's Service Line: All service lines beyond the metering point should be installed of material consisting of copper, galvanized, or PVC pipe with rating of not less than 160 psi. The size of the service line beyond the point of delivery shall not be less than 3/4 inch; however, a larger size may be needed to provide adequate service. If the customer's point of use is at a higher elevation than the point of delivery, or is at a considerable distance from the meter, the customer should consult with a reputable engineering firm to size the service line from the point of delivery.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 8. **Right of Access.** The customer must agree to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, or remove such water lines which <sup>are</sup> the property of the District located on the customer's property with the right of ingress and egress over customer's property. The District's duly authorized representative and/or other duly authorized employee of the State Health Department bearing proper credentials and identification shall be permitted to enter upon all properties for the purpose of inspection, observation, measurement, sampling, and testing, in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and Regulations.
- 9. **Interruption of Service:** The District will use reasonable diligence in supplying water service and shall make all reasonable efforts to notify affected customers in the event of a service interruption and approximate time of service restoration.
- 10. **Additional Service Volumes:** Each service connection has been sized to provide the volume of water indicated in the customer's application for service. Customers should be aware that significant increases in this volume may adversely affect quality of service and could damage facilities used to provide service. The customer is, therefore, obligated to inform the District of any actions that will require a significant increase in this volume and must obtain the District's approval before such actions are taken. Failure to notify the District or to obtain its approval for such action renders the customer liable for damages to District facilities that are caused by such actions.
- 11. **Notice of Trouble.** Customer shall notify the District immediately should the service be unsatisfactory for any reason, or should there be any defects, trouble or accidents affecting the supply of water. Such notices, if verbal, should be confirmed in writing.
- 12. **Nonstandard Service:** Customer shall pay the cost of any special installation necessary to meet his peculiar requirements for service other than standard service connection.
- 13. **Damage to District's Water System.** No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the District's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to discontinuation of water service and shall pay the cost of repairing or replacing the pipe or appurtenances as may be determined by a court of law having jurisdiction.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 15. **Relocation of Water Facilities.** District may, at the request of customer, relocate or change existing District-owned equipment. Customer shall reimburse District for such changes at actual cost including appropriate overhead.
- 16. **Revisions.** These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed from time to time by either of the two (2) following methods:
  - a. By order of the Public Service Commission upon formal application by the District, and after hearing, as provided by Commission regulation set forth in 897 KAR 5:011, Section 6.
  - b. By issuing and filing on at least twenty (20) days notice to the Commission and the public all proposed changes in the Rules and Regulations, as provided by Commission regulations set forth in 807 KAR 5:006(4) and (5) and 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8.
- 17. **Conflict.** In case of conflict between any provisions of any rate schedule and the Schedule of Rules and Regulations, the rate schedule shall apply.
- 18. **Bill Adjustment.** In conformity with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 9 of Commission regulations, whenever a meter in service is found upon periodic request or complaint test to be more than two percent (2%) fast or two percent (2%) slow, then the customer's bill will be recomputed for the period in which the meter error occurred. If the period in which the meter error existed is unknown, then the bill will be recomputed for one-half (1/2) of the elapsed time since the last previous test, but in no case to exceed twelve (12) months. When a meter is tested and it is found necessary to make a refund or back bill a customer the customer shall be given written notification of the date, location, and result of the test, as well as the amount to be deducted from or added to his regular bill.
- 19. **Leak Adjustment:** In the event of loss of water through leakage equal to, or greater than one hundred percent (100%) of normal usage, consideration will be given to adjustment of the customer's bill based on the rate per 1000 gallons for monthly usage over 70,000 gallons and the metered volume in excess of the customer's normal average of the previous three months.
- 20. All extensions to the system's transmission or service mains required to service a private development shall be subject to a Line Extension Agreement executed between the Developer and the Water District.

- 21. Fire Hydrants. The District will contract with fire protection districts, volunteer fire departments, developers and others to install and maintain fire hydrants and supply water for fire protection; provided, however, that (1) such users cannot use pumps to pull water from the hydrants, and (2) use of hydrants be strictly limited to authorized periodic drill purposes and emergency (i.e., fire fighting) use only.
- 22. Purchased Water Adjustment Clause. The District will implement upon PSC approval a purchased water adjustment designed to recover the increased costs of water purchased due to the fact that the District is not financially able to absorb the increased costs from its supplier.

**SCHEDULE OF SPECIAL SERVICE CHARGES**

The following charges for special services shall be made:

1. Service disconnection Charge: A charge of \$15.00 shall be made for all service reconnections made during regular working hours. If service is reconnected other than during regular working hours, the charge shall be \$20.00.
2. Meter Reading Recheck Charge: A charge of \$10.00 shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to be rechecked for a correct reading and the meter was not misread.
3. Meter Test at Customer's Request: Upon request and payment of \$15.00 a customer may have his meter tested provided request by the customer is not more frequent than once each twelve months. If such test shows the meter to be more than two percent fast, a refund of the \$15.00 charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly.
4. Meter Test due to Customer's Complaint: Any customer of the District may request a meter test by written application to the Public Service Commission.
5. Service Investigation Charge. A charge of \$15.00 per trip shall be made for service investigation during regular working hours if interruption of service is not caused by failure of District's facilities. The charge for investigation after working hours will be \$20.00 per trip. Any maintenance and repair of facilities beyond the District's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.

The party of the FIRST PART hereby agrees to connect to the proposed Water-  
works System of the party of the SECOND PART. The tap on fee of the proposed system

The Monthly Water Rates will be reasonable and, if a Water District or  
Association, approved by the Public Service Commission.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the SECOND PART reserves the  
right to determine the size of service connection to be used to supply water to  
the party of the FIRST PART. A 5/8x3/4 Meter will be used unless the party of the  
FIRST PART contracts for a larger meter. A separate meter must be installed for  
each residence.

A separate contract will be required for trailer parks.

It is understood and agreed that at such time as the System is constructed,  
the party of the FIRST PART agrees to connect to said System, but in the event  
the party of the FIRST PART refuses to so connect he will pay the minimum monthly  
water bill prescribed by the organization when due, The party of the FIRST PART,  
failing to connect, shall be liable for his connection fee and if, thereafter,  
party of the FIRST PART desires to connect to said system, the party of the FIRST  
PART shall be obliged to pay again the full connection charge as then stipulated  
by the party of the SECOND PART and any and all amounts previously billed. THE  
FIRST PART agrees not to resell or give away water purchased hereunder. If the  
system is constructed, but the property is not reached by the organization's line,  
any payment, less initial deposit, shall be fully refunded.

THE FIRST PART'S rights hereunder are subject to such further rules and  
regulations as the party of the SECOND PART may prescribe. The Organization  
may terminate service to any customer failing to pay a water bill when thirty  
(30) days past due or for violating the organizations regulations.

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Deposits to insure payments of monthly water bills and penalties on delinquent water accounts shall be as the party of the SECOND PART may hereafter prescribe.

The Party of the FIRST PART agrees to permit the organization to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on customer's property to be designated by the organization for each signed connection with right of ingress and egress for these purposes over customer's property, and to grant an easement for installation of water lines where required.

The party of the FIRST PART agrees to install and maintain at his own expense a service line which shall begin at the water main and extend to the dwelling or place of business and other portion of his premises.

The failure of the party of the FIRST PART to pay water charges duly imposed, shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

- A. Non-payment within ten days from the due date will be subject to a penalty of ten per cent of the delinquent account.
- B. Non-payment within thirty days from the due date will result in the water being shut off from the party of the FIRST PART'S property.
- C. In the event that it becomes necessary for the party of the SECOND PART to shut off the water, a fee of \$ 15.00 will be charged for reconnection of the service. The party of the FIRST PART will also be required to pay all delinquent accounts and pay the minimum water bill for the time the meter was disconnected, unless otherwise agreed to in writing.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Subject: Allen County Water District (ACWD) -

This Memorandum of Understanding is for the purpose of outlining procedures and setting standards for construction of a water line by a group of private citizens that will be dedicated to the Water District for operation and maintenance.

1. The group sponsoring the \_\_\_\_\_ Project agrees to select a Project Coordinator(s) who will represent the group during construction.
2. Funding for construction of the water line extension is the responsibility of the group sponsoring the Project. It is understood and agreed that funding for the Project will be complete and that funds in the amount of \_\_\_\_\_ will be deposited in a separate and distinct bank account prior to start of construction.
3. The Project Coordinator(s) agrees that plans and specifications will be prepared by a qualified engineer. Materials for, and installation of the line to conform with specifications of the plan as approved.
4. The Project Coordinator(s) agrees that a person experienced in water line construction will be employed as a working foreman/supervisor along with \_\_\_\_\_ additional laborer(s).
5. Materials for the line to be procured through the ACWD and billed to the Project Coordinator(s). Billings are due and payable upon presentation.
6. Restoration of disturbed areas will be done after completion of the Project. A reasonable delay is required in order to allow the ground to settle. One or two heavy rains are necessary to compact the soil. Restoration will be done by leveling, raking, seeding and covering with straw as/where required.
7. The ACWD will monitor construction and provide assistance which includes but is not limited to:
  - a. Coordination with a qualified engineer for preparation of plans and specifications.
  - b. Preparation of a materials list and cost estimate for the Project.

- c. Right-of-way easements as/where required.
- d. Coordination with the County Government concerning use of County personnel and equipment during construction of the Project.
- e. Provide an estimated \_\_\_\_\_ in direct financial assistance toward completion of the Project.
- f. Installation of individual water service connections.
- g. Arrange for pressure testing and sterilization of the line after completion.
- h. The ACWD reserves the right of final determination concerning location of the distribution line and service connections.

8. The ACWD residential service connection charge is \$400.00. It is further understood and agreed that each sponsor will receive a credit of \$200.00 toward cost of the distribution line for \_\_\_\_\_ service(s). Additional service connections to be at the standard rate. Credit will also be given for deposits made to the ACWD during previous sign-up campaigns. a sponsor who elects to delay installation of his individual service(s) is entitled to receive service under the above conditions upon request.

9. In reference to 807 KRS 5:066,12b, it is also understood and agreed that the group sponsoring the Project will receive a rebate of the average cost of fifty (50) feet of line for each new service installed directly to the line. The rebate will be made annually for a period of ten (10) years; however, not to exceed actual cost of the line.

10. It is further understood and agreed that upon completion and acceptance by the ACWD of the water line for operation and maintenance, the line becomes the property of the ACWD and will be operated in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the ACWD and applicable Kentucky Statutes.
