RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Meters will be read monthly on the 20th of each month.
2. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first of each month. Said bills will state that they are to be paid within ten days. If not paid by the 10th of the following month, water service will be discontinued immediately.
3. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission on the property to be served.
4. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and may be appealed to the District Commission.
5. The principal place of business of the District will be the residence of W. D. Juett, Route #6, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601.
6. Water bills may be mailed to Elkhorn Water District, P. O. Box 67, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601, or paid at No. 5 above.
7. If water service is discontinued because of failure to pay the water bill, a \$15.00 charge will be required before service is reinstated.
8. A \$5.00 deposit will be required if a customer requests an accuracy check of his meter. If his meter checks accurate, he forfeits his \$5.00 deposit to pay for the checking of his meter. If his meter tests inaccurate, then his \$5.00 deposit is refunded and the District installs him a new meter at no cost to him.
9. A deposit of \$20.00 required of tenants, which is refundable.
