ADDENDUM

THIS ADDENDUM to the Water Purchase Contract made and entered into this the $20 \, \mathrm{th}$ day of $20 \, \mathrm{August}$, 1992, by and between the City of Greensburg, of 105 W. Hodgenville Avenue, Greensburg, Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as "City" and the Green-Taylor Water District, of 250 Bluff Boom Rd., Greensburg, Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as "District,"

WHEREAS, by Resolution enacted on the <u>20th</u> day of <u>August</u>, 1992, by the City, it was agreed to extend the Water Purchase Contract to sell water to the District for an additional period of five (5) years, through and including the year of 2036, and in accordance with the provisions of the said Resolution this Addendum was approved, and the execution of this Addendum carrying out the said Resolution by the Mayor, and attested by the Clerk, was duly authorized, and

WHEREAS, by Resolution enacted on the <u>20th</u> day of <u>August</u>, 1992, by the District, it was agreed to purchase water and to extend the Water Purchase Contract for an additional period of five (5) years, through and including the year of 2036, and in accordance with the provisions set forth in said Resolution this Addendum was approved, and the execution of this Addendum by the Chairman, attested by the Secretary, was duly authorized,

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual agreements hereinafter set forth, the City and the District agree as follows:

- 1. This Addendum shall extend the Water Purchase Contract dated July 7, 1986, between the City and the District for an additional period of ten (10) years, through and including the year of 2036, and therafter may be renewed or extended for such term, or terms, as may be agreed upon by the City and District,
- 2. All other provisions of the Water Purchase Contract dated July 7, 1986, are to remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, acting under the authority of their respective governing bodies, have caused this Addendum to be duly executed in three (3) counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original.
