(3) If the District is unable to continue providing water service to an existing customer at a pressure of at least 30 psig at the meter but can do so if an individual pump is installed on the customer's side of the point of connection, it shall at its own expense install such a pump and shall be responsible for the pump's maintenance and repair. If an installed pump fails and such failure is not the result of the customer's negligence or willful misconduct, the District shall at its own expense replace the failed pump and shall be responsible for the replacement pump's maintenance and repair.** (N)

k. [Reserved for Future Use]

If the applicant/Customer's point of usage is at a higher elevation than the meter, 1. the customer should consult with a reputable engineering firm to properly size the service line from the meter to the point of usage.

m. Subject to the District's approval, an applicant/Customer may install an individual The District reserves the right to require discontinuance and pressure booster system. disconnection should the private booster system have a detrimental effect on the District's system.
