RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are hereby adopted to change by the Commission at any time. These rules and regulations are intended to supplement the Bond Resolution, the Rate Resolution and the By-Laws. All rules and regulations are subject to approval of the Public Service Commission.

- A. All taps and connections to the mains of the District shall be made by and/or under the direction and supervision of the District personnel.
- B. Water service may be discontinued by the District for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition of service and especially for any of the following reasons:
 - 1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 - 2. Failure to report to the District additions to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 - 3. Resale of water.
 - 4. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep in suitable state of repair.
 - 5. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or valves or permitting such tampering by others.
 - 6. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separated water supply to premises which receive water from the District.
 - 7. Non-payment of bills.

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C. Any customer desiring to discontinue the water service to his premises for any reason must give notice of disconnection in writing at the business office of the District; otherwise, a

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Customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered by the District until said notice is received by the District.

- D. Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the user's agreement unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.
- E. 1. Bills for water service are due and payable at the office of the District, or to any designated agent, on the date of issue. The past due date shall be the ~~fifteenth day~~ after the date of issue. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first first day of each month,
 - 2. All bills not paid on or before the past due date shall be deemed delinquent. The district may serve a customer a written final notice of said delinquency. If delinquent bill is not paid within ten days after date of such final notice, which makes a total number of twenty-five (25) days from date of issue of bill; the water supply to the customer may be discontinued without further notice.
- F. Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$2500 will be made for reconnection of water service, but the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owned by the customer to the District have been paid.
- G. The District may require from any customer or applicant a cash deposit or any other guarant to secure payments of bills in an amount not to exceed 2/12 of estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant. Interest at 6% per annum will be paid on a deposit from date of deposit.
- H. All meters shall be installed, renewed and maintained at the

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expense of the District and the District reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used.

- I. Upon written request of any customer, the meter serving said customer shall be tested by the District. Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within 12 month spreceding the requested test; otherwise, a charge of \$2.00 will be made and then only if the test indicates meter accuracy within the limits of 2%. If a meter is inaccurate in excess of 2%, adjustments shall be made for the two preeding months prior to test according to the inaccuract in excess of 2%.
- J. Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water donsumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register.
- K. The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and which such interruptions occur will endeavor to reestablish service withthe shortest possible delay. When the service is interrupted all consumers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.
- L. All extension of service should be referred to P.S.C. rules and regulations of 807 KAR 5:066E, Section 12.
- M. ~~The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs. No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the District may be deemed necessary.~~
- N. Customers having boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the District must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vaccum valve on the stream line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice,...

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- O. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall ~~shall at all reasonable~~ hours be subject to inspection by the District.
- P. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.
- Q. The customer's serviceline shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the District rules and regulation and with the regulations of the Department of Health.
- R. If any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or other injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customers, member of his household, his agent or employee, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer. Justification is that water district is a non-profit organization and do not have access money to pay for some- one elses damages.
- S. Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees onle. The customer shall not sell the water to any other person.
- T. All customers shall grant or convey, or shall be caused to be granted or conveyed, to the District a perpetual easement and right of way across any property owned or controlled by the customer ~~wherever~~ said easement or right of way is necessary for the District water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish service to the customer.
- U. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system whose decision may be appealed to the Commission of the District within ten days; otherwise, the operator's decision will be ~~final~~ final.
