RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Commissioners have, and will make all policies concerning the North Marshall Water District; and from time to time alter, delete or revise any policy according to existing needs.
2. The Supt. and office management shall be governed at all times by policies adopted by the Commissioners and shall enforce them impartially.
3. All home supplies, such as wells, reservoirs, springs or cisterns shall be discontinued from the public water supply - valves not accepted.
4. Two or more separate owned homes, permanent or mobile, may not be served from one meter.
5. All commercial businesses and multiple housing units must be served by a one inch meter or larger.
6. Permission must be secured before drilling under any highway.
7. Meter ownership cannot be transferred from one property owner to another without transferring the property.
8. When a rental home is vacated, the meter will automatically be transferred back to the property owner at the proper rate.
9. After a meter is set it cannot be moved to another location unless the owner pays the moving cost.
10. A water user who discontinues service between meter readings will be charged 25 cents per 100 gallons used, or the minimum or more if used. The user at meter reading time will be charged the \$4.75 minimum.
11. Water bills become delinquent after the 15th. of each month. A 10% penalty will be added on all meters until the bill is paid.
12. Service will be discontinued immediately after second month bill is past due without notice, and a \$5.00 service charge plus delinquent bills and penalties must be paid before services can be restored.
13. The District will tolerate two months delinquent bills ONLY, but will not allow one continuous month in arrear.
14. When cash or checks are received for partial payments on delinquent bills, the payment will be returned and service discontinued.
15. When payments are made by bad checks, if the bill is delinquent, service shall be discontinued immediately.
16. a \$15.00 deposit is required from all renters before service can begin, unless the property owner assumes responsibility for all water bills. The deposit is refunded when final water bill is paid in full.
17. Water will be turned off ONLY, when consumer requests such or for delinquent bills.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 18. The Water District is responsible for leaks, breaks, etc. up to the meter. The user is responsible for all water that flows through the meter.
- 19. The consumer is privileged to read, check, or examine his meter at anytime - however, he shall be responsible for damaging or mutilating any part of meter or meter box.
- 20. Unused meters will be charged the monthly minimum rate, and when the consumer refuses to pay the minimum, the monthly minimum and monthly penalty will be brought forward each month until the amount is equal to his installation charges. The consumer will then have the privilege of paying in full or forfeit his installation fee.
- 21. Water service can be discontinued permanently at any time at the consumer's request; however, his installation fee will be forfeited.
- 22. There shall be three home rate minimums, \$1.50, \$2.50, and \$4.75. Those living in the District will be required to pay \$4.75 minimum on one meter. They may have additional connections at \$1.50 per month if meter is not installed, or \$2.50 on unused meters that are installed. Out of District dwellers may have stand-by service for vacant lots or vacant homes at \$1.50 min. or \$2.50 minimum as they may choose. I
- 23. All occupied houses owned or rented shall be subject to \$4.75 minimum. I
- 24. The Water District will serve any individual where property is out of the District provided the individual will obtain easements for meter space and run his own private line.
- 25. The Water District will install laterals for any individual to his meter not to exceed 50 feet. When an extension of a main line is necessary a study will be made for feasibility.
- 26. The Water District will install all meters on consumer's property provided the property is adjacent to road on which pipe line is located.
- 27. Stub-off or stand-by service for vacant lots shall be \$1.50 per month, payable 12 months in advance when water is available.
- 28. Cottage owners shall pay \$4.75 minimum per month as long as water is used, but must pay three months minimum. The remainder of year that meter is unused may be \$2.50 per month. I
- 29. Winterized or vacated cottages or homes can be subject to \$2.50 minimum through winter months provided the district is notified to turn off water and lock meter. For this service there will be a \$5.00 charge when service is restored.
- 30. When stand-by services are changed to \$4.75 minimum, credit will be given for advance payments. I
- 31. Non residents shall keep the District informed when changing addresses or transferring of property.

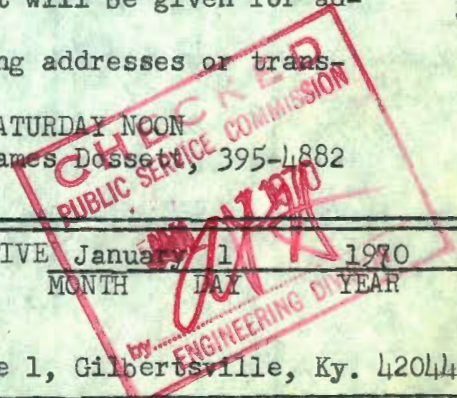
