The following rates, rules and regulations are subject to change by the Board of Commissioners at any time. They are also subject to the approval of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

These rates, rules and regulations are intended to supplement the Bond Resolution and the By-Laws.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Ohio County Water District, Ohio County, Kentucky as follows;

Section 1.

That there shall be charged the users of the Ohio County Water District system, a monthly charge as follows:

Section 5

Any prospective consumer desiring to connect onto the water system shall apply to the Board of Commissioners or its duly designated representative, and obtain a permit therefor and shall pay the sum of \$365.00 which shall be a tapping fee for the installation of the meter, provided, however, that all consumers who apply to the Water District prior to the beginning of construction of the original distribution lines shall pay the sum of only \$100.00 tapping fee. There shall be paid to the Ohio County Water District an addition charge by ~~_____~~ each consumer ~~_____~~ as a meter deposit, which deposit shall be refunded to the said consumer when he ceases to use water, upon written notice from said consumer that he desires to discontinue said water service, unless, said consumer owes the Water District for water service furnished to him, in which event, said deposit shall be credited on his account. The Ohio County Water District may require from customer or applicant for service a minimum cash deposit or other guarantee to secure payment of bills of an amount not to exceed 2/12 of estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant. The utility shall issue to every customer from whom a deposit is received a certificate of deposit, showing the name of the customer, the initial premises occupied, date and amount of deposit. The utility will pay 6% interest per annum on all deposits held.

Any prospective consumer desiring to connect onto the water system shall apply to the Board of Commissioners or its duly designated representative, and obtain a permit therefore and shall pay the sum of \$365.00 which shall be a tapping fee for the installation of the meter. There shall be paid to the Ohio County Water District an additional each consumer as a meter deposit, which deposit shall be refunded to the said consumer when he ceases to use water, upon written notice from said consumer that he desires to discontinue said water service, unless, said consumer owes the Water District for water service furnished to him, in which event, said deposit shall be credited on his account. The Ohio County Water District may require from customer or applicant for service, a minimum cash deposit or other guarantee to secure payment of bills of an amount not to exceed 2/12 of an estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant. The utility shall issue to every customer from whom a deposit is received a certificate of deposit, showing the name of the customer and the initial premises occupied, date and amount of deposit. The utility will pay 6% per annum on all deposits held.
