1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
2. Any resident or business of West McCracken Water District is eligible for water service from the District. The District will require that the prospective customer contract to use service for one (1) year or more and provide guarantee for such service if an extension of water main up to 50 feet is required for that service as per 807:KAR 5:006, Section 11 (1).
3. Water service will be terminated within 24 hours after receiving a written request from the customer requesting discontinuance. Request for discontinuance may also be made in person. Water service will be terminated by phone provided customer gives their Social Security Number. The West McCracken Water District Office Hours are: 1st thru 10th of month, 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, then 11th thru end of the month, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM, closed Saturday, Sunday and Holidays.
4. Customer complaints concerning the District's service should be made in person or by phone during the previously stated office hours. The next page contains the customer complaint form used by the District.

5. The District may require any applicant for service to pay a cash deposit to assure payment of bills. This deposit will be based on average bills of similar customers in the District. This deposit shall not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such customer.

The District shall place the deposits in a special account where interest is allowed to compound. Interest gained on the deposits shall be refunded or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis.

If the District retains a customer's deposit for more than eighteen (18) months, the District shall notify the customer in writing that, at the customer's request, the deposit will be recalculated every eighteen (18) months based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account with the District differs by more than ten dollars (\$10.00) for residential customers, or more than ten percent (10%) for nonresidential customers, from the deposit calculated from actual usage, then the District shall refund any over payment and may collect any underpayment by a credit or an addition to the customer's bill.

The District requires a customer applying for service to sign a Contract For Water Service. A copy of this contract is contained on the next page.

6. All applications for service shall be accompanied by a Service Connection Charge in the amounts:

- For a 5/8" x 3/4" Meter - \$1,280.00
- For a 1" Meter - Actual Cost
- For a 2" Meter - Actual Cost
- For a 3" Meter - Actual Cost
- For a 4" Meter - Actual Cost

For **NEW** meter installations, the WATER USER agrees to contract for service no less than one year, if a main extension is required. Twenty-Four (24) hours notice must be given to the SUPPLIER whenever the WATER USER desires to discontinue water service. Following installation of the water service, the meter will not be installed and service turned on until the WATER USER has installed the service line, shut off valve and provided the SUPPLIER with a plumbing permit. The WATER USER will receive a water bill beginning with the first billing period following installation of the meter.

The WATER USER agrees to permit the SUPPLIER to lay, maintain, repair, remove and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meters at a point on WATER USER'S property, to be designated by the SUPPLIER for each signed connection with the right of ingress and egress on property. The WATER USER shall guarantee proper protection for the property of the SUPPLIER placed on the WATER USER'S premises and shall permit access to it only by authorized representatives of the SUPPLIER. Damages to the property of the SUPPLIER will be repaired at the expense of the WATER USER.

The WATER USER shall install and/or maintain, at his own expense, a service line, which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or place of use. The WATER USER agrees to install a shutoff valve adjacent to the service as required by the SUPPLIER.

The WATER USER agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the SUPPLIER, now in force, or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended or changed.

The WATER USER agrees to claim no damages due to loss of flow or pressure when such loss is necessary to make alteration, repairs or improvements.

The WATER USER agrees not to interconnect a private or other water system with the lines supplied by the SUPPLIER.

Non-payment on or before stated due date will result in a penalty of 10% of the delinquent amount. Nonpayment within twenty days of the mailing date of the bill will result in water being shut off from the WATER USER'S property. Notice will be sent by mail to the WATER USER concerning this penalty. In the event it becomes necessary to discontinue water service, due to nonpayment, a fee will be charged for reconnection of the service. The WATER USER will also be required to pay all delinquent accounts. The WATER USER understands the SUPPLIER is not responsible for mail deliveries.

13. The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs or other reasons.

No person shall be entitled to damages or a payment refund for any interruptions of service which, in the option of the District, was deemed necessary.

The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruptions of service, and when such interruptions occur, service will be re-established with the shortest possible delay. When service is interrupted, all customers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever possible.

14. Meters are read each month beginning on or about the 20<sup>th</sup> day of each month.


15. Customers are billed each month on the first day of the month.

16. Bills are payable on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of each month. If bills are not paid within 15 days of date of billing, a penalty of 10% of the bill shall be added. Service will be discontinued if bills are not paid by the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the month. Five (5) days written notice will be given to customers before service is discontinued. An extension of 30 days is given a customer for an unpaid bill if a case of hardship is indicated.

A fee of \$75.00 shall be required to re-establish disconnected service during office hours. This includes re-establishing service which was disconnected for nonpayment of bills. The District shall require payment of all delinquent water bills, including penalties, in full before reconnection is made.

A fee of \$20.00 shall be required to transfer services to a new customer or reconnect a service which was voluntarily discontinued.

A fee of \$40.00 shall be required for a special meter reading at the customer's request, and the second meter reading shows the original reading was correct, no charge will be assessed if the original reading was incorrect.

A fee of \$100.00 shall be required to perform meter testing at the customer's request if the meter test shows the meter is not more than 2% (two percent) fast. The fee and over billing shall be refunded if the test shows the meter is more than 2% (two percent) fast. The customer shall be back billed if the meter test shows the meter is more than 2% (two percent) slow.

A service charge of \$20.00 shall be required for all returned checks.

I understand that adjustments are figured by the difference between my average bill and the bill that reflects the leak. The adjustment is then based on West McCracken Water District assuming 50% of the loss and I am responsible for the other 50% of the loss plus my average bill. I further understand that even though an adjustment is to be considered, I am still responsible for the bill and that should I be disconnected for nonpayment, the entire amount plus \$20.00 reconnect fee must be paid before service will be restored and any adjustment made will be credited to my account.

I also understand that during the lifetime of my water service line, only two leak adjustments will be permitted. Each of these adjustments may cover a maximum of two billing periods. Before a third adjustment can be considered, the entire water service line from the meter box to my house or structure must be replaced and that I must submit evidence of this fact before the third adjustment is given. If plastic pipe is used for any repair of underground water service lines, it must be no less than class 160 P.S.I., either C.T.S or I.P.S. pipe. THE USE OF RADIATOR CLAMPS, KING NIPPLES, OR THE EQUIVALENT CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

I realize that no adjustment will be made until this form (completed in its entirety, signed and dated) and my plumber's statement are returned to West McCracken Water District.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

20. Multiple Services

A. Permanent Single Family Dwellings.

Under no circumstances shall more than one permanent single family residential dwelling be provided service through a single meter.

B. Commercial Trailer Park.

(1) Definition. A commercial trailer park shall be defined as two (2) or more units occupying a common parcel of land and producing revenue of two (2) or more units designated as a trailer park by the Kentucky Department Health for reasons of health and public welfare.

(2) Minimum Bill. Rates shall be the approved minimum rate for the meter size as established in B. (3).

(3) Meter Size. The utility shall determine the size of meter necessary to provide adequate services and the meter installation shall be paid for by the customer at the prescribed rate in effect. The following schedule of meter sizes and maximum number of trailer spaces shall be adopted as the basis for selection by the Water District under normal conditions:

D. Other Combinations

Multiple service for a permanent single family residential dwelling in combination with one trailer home not otherwise classified as a commercial trailer park may be served from a single meter. The minimum rate shall be the approved minimum rate for the meter size in use.

21. Extension of Main

A. Normal Extension.

An extension of fifty feet or less along an existing road shall be made by the West McCracken Water District to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one year or more and provide a guarantee for such service.

B. Other Extensions.

(1) When an extension of the West McCracken Water District's main to serve an applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than fifty feet per applicant, the District may require the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty feet per customer to be deposited with the District by the applicant or the applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension. Cost of the total extension shall be established from accurate records of construction cost by the District, including materials, labor, supervision, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other cost incurred by the District and made available to the applicant or applicants receiving service.

(2) Each customer receiving service under such extension will be reimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the purpose of rule shall be the refund period, the West McCracken Water District shall refund to the customer or customers who paid for the excessive footage, the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension in place for each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom, but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the District. After the end of the refund period, (10 years) no refund will be made. Customers who are not original investors shall be required to pay in addition to the tap-on fee their pro-rata share of the of the original cost of the extension for a period of ten (10) years. Said cost to be used in reimbursing the original investors.

C. Extension To a Real Estate Subdivision.

(1) Applicants Cost of Extension. An applicant desiring an extension to a real estate subdivision will initially be required to deposit a minimum of \$500.00 with the District prior to the development of preliminary construction drawings and cost estimate by the District's authorized engineering representative. If, after the development of this preliminary information, the applicant withdraws the application for the real estate subdivision extension, the excess deposit over and above the actual administrative costs incurred by the District on the extension up to the time of withdrawal will be refunded to the applicant. Should the applicant desire to continue with the extension, the District may require the total estimated cost of the extension to be deposited with the District by the applicant. The preliminary costs incurred by the District and the initial deposit paid by the applicant will be included in the total estimated costs

and total required deposit, respectively. The cost of the total extension shall be established from accurate records of construction cost by the District, including materials, labor, supervision, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other costs incurred by the District. Records of cost shall be maintained by the District and made available to the applicant receiving service.

If after the construction of the extension, the actual cost of the extension is less than the total amount deposited by the applicant, the excess shall be refunded to the applicant. If the actual total cost of the extension is greater than the total amount deposited with the District by the applicant, an amount equal to the excess in cost shall be deposited with the District prior to the District's final acceptance of the extension.

D. Construction Procedure.

(1) Extensions by Water District. Water line extensions extended to customers under item (A) Normal extension, (B) Subdivision, shall be installed by the Water District's forces, or by a competent contractor employed by the Water District or by the person or persons desiring service and approved in writing by the District.

(2) Construction Drawings. Plans and specifications for proposed extensions shall be prepared by the West McCracken Water District's authorized engineering representative and shall comply with the District's standards, shall meet the requirements of the Kentucky Department of Health, the Public Service Commission and other applicable federal, ~~Public Service Commission~~ agencies.

(3) Real Estate Subdivision Plats. A reproducible plat of a real estate subdivision as recorded in the County Court Clerk's office shall be furnished by the developer for use by the District's engineer in laying out the proposed water lines.

(4) Utility Easements. Water mains shall generally be laid in a 15 foot permanent easement on private property. A 15 foot temporary construction easement adjacent to the 15 foot permanent easement shall also be required where practical, from each private property owner. The cost of obtaining easements shall be included in the cost of construction as set forth in items 21B and 21C above.

(5) Service Lines and Service Connection Charges. Meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter will be installed by the Water District as required to customers adjacent to said main extensions, and the Water District shall be reimbursed for this service by the property owner in the form of a Service Connection Charge current at the time the service is made.

(6) Potable Water-Maintenance of Lines. After the mains have been installed, tested, and chlorinated to the satisfaction of the Health Department, the West McCracken Water District shall then accept the responsibility for furnishing potable water to the extension and for maintenance of the lines including meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter.

**SECTION II – DEPOSIT**

An advance deposit equal to 5 percent of the estimated water line construction costs made by a developer shall be paid to West McCracken and held for a period not to exceed one year from the date the water line construction is fully complete and all rights and interest of ownership have transferred to West McCracken. The deposit shall be used by West McCracken to offset all expenses incurred by it for re-grading and re-landscaping made necessary by normal ground settling on and around the water main installation that is not repaired by the developer. An itemized list of all charges against the deposit, along with the unused portion, shall be provided to the developer within one year from the time West McCracken has accepted ownership of the water main extension.

**SECTION III – TESTING AND INSPECTION**

All construction of the main extension shall be approved by an inspector employed by the Developer's consulting engineer, and all pressure leakage and bacteriology tests shall be performed in the presence of the inspector. The District has the right to inspect construction at any time.

**FIRE DEPARTMENTS:**

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for the purpose of fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15th day of the following calendar month.

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water.

A non-reporting user's usage shall be presumed to 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting user may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and may adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting user shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting user shall also be assessed a penalty of \$25.00 for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.
