

ADDENDUM TO WATER PURCHASE CONTRACT

THIS ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT made and entered into this the 15th day of July, 1985, between the CITY OF WILLIAMSBURG, Williamsburg, Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as the "City", and CUMBERLAND FALLS HIGHWAY WATER DISTRICT, hereinafter referred to as the "District".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the "District" and the "City": have heretofore entered into a water purchase contract dated February 12, 1969, and now mutually desire to amend said contract as set out hereinafter. For and in consideration of the mutual promises made hereinafter said agreement is amended as follows:

That the City of Williamsburg agrees to furnish the "District" at the point of delivery during the remainder of the term of this agreement or any renewal or extension thereof, potable treated water meeting applicable as purity standards of the State Board of Health in such quantity as may be required by the "District" (not to exceed five (5) million gallons per month).

B. THE DISTRICT AGREES:

1) (Rates and payment date) To pay the "City", not later than the 20th day of each month, for the delivered at a rate of a flat charge of One (\$1.00) Dollar per thousand (1,000) gallons.

C: IT IS FURTHER MUTUALLY AGREED BETWEEN THE CITY AND DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

5) (Modification of Contract) That the provisions of this contract pertaining to the schedule of rates to be paid

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by the District for water delivered are subject to modification at the end of every twelve (12) month period from May 1, 1985, to May 1, 1986, and continuing thereafter.

In all other manners and respect, the agreement is herewith ratified.
