- 2. That Garrison, shall sell, and South Shore shall purchase, a minimum monthly amount of 1 (one) million gallons, at a rate of \$ 2.00 per (1000) one thousand gallon for a total payment of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) and any taxes that may apply.
- 3. That any and all gallons sold to the City above and beyond three million gallons shall be sold to the City at \$2.20 per (1000) one thousand gallon.
