FIRE DEPARTMENTS:

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for the purpose of fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15th day of the following calendar month.


Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water.

A non-reporting user's usage shall be presumed to 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting user may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and may adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting user shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting user shall also be assessed a penalty of \$ 100.⁰⁰ for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Meters are read monthly between the 15th and the 20th of each month.
2. Bills are dated and mailed on the first of each month and will state that they are to be paid within 10 days. A penalty of 10% is added to all unpaid bills on the 10th day of each month. **The rates will be included with the bill that is sent in December of each year. All complaints will be handled in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 9.**
3. Inquiries may be made to the operator and complaints made to the local Water Board. All complaints will be handled in accordance with 807 KAR 5:006 Section 9.
4. The customer agrees to grant to the Utility, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement in, over, under and upon the above described land, with the right to erect, construct, install, and lay, and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace, and remove water pipelines and appurtenant facilities, together with the right to utilize adjoining lands belonging to the User for the purpose of ingress to and egress from the above described lands.
5. The customer shall install and maintain at the Customer's expense a service line which shall begin at the meter and extend to the dwelling or place of use. The service line shall connect with the distribution system of the Utility at the nearest place of desired use by the Customer, provided the Utility had determined in advance that the system has sufficient capacity to permit delivery of water at that point.
6. The Customer agrees to comply with and be bound by the Articles, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the water district, now in force, or as hereafter duly and legally supplemented, amended, or changed. The Customer also agrees to pay for water at such

rates, time and place as shall be determined by the Utility, and agrees to the imposition of such penalties for noncompliance as are now set out in the Customer's Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, or which may be hereafter adopted and imposed by the Utility. All rates, charges, and rules are subject to the Public Service Commission.

- 7. **The Utility requires from its customers or applicant for service a minimum cash deposit or guarantee to secure the payment of bills in the amount of \$30.00 for "3/4" meter users and 2/12 of the estimated annual bill for users with meters larger than "3/4".** Should the account be fully paid at the time of termination of service to the User, the deposit shall be refunded by the Utility within a reasonable time thereafter.

The Utility shall issue a certificate of deposit for customers. The Utility will pay interest at a rate no greater than it receives in interest and at no time shall the rate exceed 6% per annum accruing from the date of deposit.

- 8. The Utility shall have final authority in any question of location of any service line connection to its distribution system; shall determine the allocation of water to Customers in the event of a water shortage; and may shut off water to a Customer who allows a connection or extension to be made of the member's service line for the purpose of supplying water to another Customer. In the event the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all of the needs of the customers, or in the event there is a shortage of water, the Utility may prorate the water available among the various customers on such basis as is deemed equitable by the Board of Commissioners, and may also prescribe a schedule of hours covering use of water for garden purposes by particular Customers and require adherence thereto or prohibit the use of water for garden purposes; provided that, if at any time the total water supply shall be insufficient to meet all of the needs of all of the Customers, the Utility must first

satisfy all of the needs of all Customers for domestic purposes before supplying any water for livestock purposes and before supplying any water for garden purposes. (See Water Shortage Response Plan filed August 01, 1988.)

9. The Customer agrees that no other present or future source of water will be connected to any waterlines served to the Utility's waterlines and will disconnect from the present water supply prior to connecting to and switching to the Utility's system and shall eliminate their present or future cross-connections in the Customer's system.

10. This Utility may refuse or discontinue to serve an applicant or Customer for the following reasons:

(1) For failing to comply with its rules and regulations, after the Utility has made reasonable effort to induce the Customer to comply with the rules as filed with the Public Service Commission. Discontinuation will result only after written notice of at least 10 days be given the Customer to his last known address.

(2) When a dangerous condition is found on the Customer's premises, service may be discontinued without notice. The Customer will be notified immediately and given the reasons for discontinuance and corrective action to restore service.

(3) When a Customer refuses to provide reasonable access to the premises for the purposes of installation. Such action shall be taken only when corrective action negotiated between the utility and the customer has failed to resolve the situation and after the customer has been given at least ten (10) days written notice of termination.

(4) When a Customer is indebted to the Utility for service furnished and for non-payment of bills, the Utility must make a

reasonable effort to induce the Customer to pay his/her bill. If the Customer's outstanding balance exceeds two month's billing, a written notice will be sent. The notice will state that the service will be discontinued in 10 days. Such termination notice shall be exclusive of and separate from the original bill. Service shall not be terminated before twenty (20) days after the date of the original bill.

(5) If prior to discontinuance of service there is delivered to the Utility Office payment of the amount in arrears this discontinuance of service shall not be made, or where a written certificate had been signed by a physician, public health office, or registered nurse that in the opinion of the person making certification will aggravate an existing illness on the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until 30 days elapse from the time of notification.

(6) For fraudulent or illegal use of service. Where all causes have been corrected, the Utility shall restore service by reconnection. ~~A charge of \$8.00 will be applied for a reconnection fee.~~ See special non-recurring charges.

11. Customers will pay a connection fee upon signature of the contract, which will be taken as a guarantee, but will be forfeited if the contract is not honored.

12. Customer's annual usage will be computed in February for the previous year through the mid December meter reading. That usage will include an average monthly usage calculated from the year's totals and compared with the current month's usage to be used for monitoring purposes. Customers will be notified of unusual deviations in usage in the event that corrective action might be taken in the event of a leak.

Customer's usage is computed monthly. The monthly usages will be entered into an annual report that will generate a history of usage for each customer and meter location.
