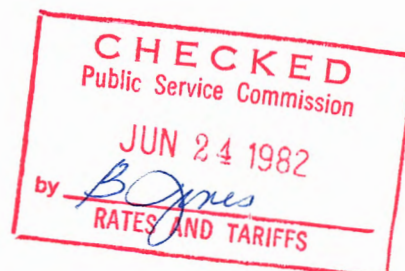

1. Application: This tariff shall cover the entire service area of the Association, which consists of Northeast Boyle County and East and Southeast Mercer County.

2. Availability of service: The Association does not distinguish between classes of customers in making water service available.

3. Rates:

(I) 4. Minimum charge: Seven dollars forty-five cents (\$7.45) minimum charge up to and including the first thousand (1,000) gallons per month.

5. Delayed payment charge: Ten percent (10%) penalty for all bills not paid by the 10th of the month following issuance of the bill. No discount for early or pre-payment.

6. Term: No fixed term.

7. Special rules: No special rules and regulations are in effect concerning this tariff.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are subject to change by the water association commissioners at any time subject to approval by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

- 1.) The association will impose a penalty of 10% on all bills not paid by the 10th of the month.
- 2.) When a customer's meter is found to be inoperative the association will use the average of the preceeding three months to compute the customer's bill.
- 3.) All water meters will be read on the 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd and 24th of each month, weather permitting.
- 4.) A deposit not to exceed \$25.00 is required from persons who are renting from members of the association and interest at the rate of 6% will be paid on demand on all deposits.
- 5.) All customers will be billed in accordance with the rate schedule of the association.
- 6.) The office of the association is located at 116 E. Main Street, Burgin, Kentucky 40310 and the office hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Tuesday thru Saturday. The office will be closed on Mondays.
- 7.) Water usage for each member is computed each year, based on total dollars water sold related to profit or loss, and recorded on each members accounts receivable ledger sheet.
- 8.) New members of the association will pay a tap fee of \$300.00 for water (I) service.
