RULES AND REGULATIONS

THIS SCHEDULE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNS THE FURNISHING OF WATER SERVICE BY MCKINNEY WATER DISTRICT HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE UTILITY. NO EMPLOYEE OR INDIVIDUAL DIRECTOR OF THE UTILITY IS PERMITTED TO MAKE AN EXCEPTION TO RATES, RULES OR REGULATIONS. ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE TO BE IN EFFECT SO LONG AS THEY ARE NOT IN CONFLICT WITH PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION RULES AND REGULATIONS. THE UTILITY IS FURTHER SUBJECT TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION EVEN THOUGH NOT CONTAINED HEREIN.

REVISIONS

THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS MAY BE REVISED, AMENDED, SUPPLEMENTED OR OTHERWISE CHANGED FROM TIME TO TIME SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION, AND SHALL HAVE THE SAME FORCE AS THE PRESENT RULES AND REGULATIONS.

SERVICE AREA

THE UTILITY FURNISHES WATER SERVICE TO APPROXIMATELY 265 CUSTOMERS LOCATED AT MCKINNEY, KENTUCKY AND ALONG HIGHWAY 78 IN LINCOLN COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

AVAILABILITY

WATER SERVICE IS AVAILABLE TO ANY DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL CONSUMER WITHIN THE UTILITY'S AREA AS LONG AS THE UTILITY HONORS CONTRACT MADE WITH THE CITY OF STANFORD, KENTUCKY.

WATER FAILURE

THE UTILITY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR WATER FAILURE ONLY WHEN IN CONTROL OF THE UTILITY'S EMPLOYEES. NO CONSUMER IS PAID DAMAGES FOR EQUIPMENT UNLESS SUCH DAMAGES ARE SPECIFICALLY FOUND TO BE CAUSED BY AN ACT OF NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE UTILITY OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

PROTECTION BY CONSUMER

CONSUMER SHALL PROTECT THE EQUIPMENT OF THE UTILITY ON HIS PREMISES AND SHALL NOT INTERFERE WITH UTILITY'S PROPERTY OR PERMIT INTERFERENCE EXCEPT BY DULY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UTILITY.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

CONSUMER SHALL GIVE IMMEDIATE NOTICE TO THE UTILITY OF ANY IRREGULARITIES OR UNSATISFACTORY SERVICE AND OF ANY DEFECTS KNOWN TO CONSUMER.

MAINTENANCE

THE UTILITY MAY AT ANY TIME DEEMED NECESSARY, SUSPEND WATER SERVICE TO ANY CONSUMER OR CONSUMERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING REPAIRS, CHANGES OR IMPROVEMENTS UPON ANY PART OF ITS SYSTEM. THE UTILITY SHALL GIVE REASONABLE NOTICE OF SUCH SUSPENSION OF SERVICE TO THE CONSUMER.

THE UTILITY SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THAT PORTION OF THE SERVICE LINE INSTALLED BY THE UTILITY AND THE CONSUMER SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THAT PORTION THEREOF INSTALLED BY THE CONSUMER.

EXTENSION OF SERVICE

EXTENSION OF SERVICE SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH 807 KAR 5:066, SECTION 12. THE LINE HAS A TERMINAL END INTO THE WATER LINE OF THE MCKINNEY WATER ASSOCIATION SO THERE MAY BE NO EXTENSION OF THE ORIGINAL LINE, HOWEVER, LATERALS MAY BE PLACED ON THE LINE TO SERVICE THE AREA.

LINE RELOCATIONS

WHEN NECESSARY TO MOVE OR RELOCATE FACILITIES, THE COST WILL BE PAID BY PARTY OR PARTIES REQUESTING SUCH RELOCATION.

BILLING, COLLECTION, PENALTIES

BILLS FOR WATER SERVICE FURNISHED BY THE WATER SYSTEM WILL BE MAILED NO LATER THAN THE LAST DAY OF EACH MONTH AND WILL BE DUE AND PAYABLE WITHIN 15 DAYS (OR BY THE 15TH DAY OF THE FOLLOWING MONTH). A 10% LATE PAYMENT PENALTY WILL BE APPLICABLE AFTER THE DUE DATE OF ANY ACCOUNT.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

DEPOSITS

THE UTILITY MAY REQUIRE FROM ANY CUSTOMER OR APPLICANT FOR SERVICE A CASH DEPOSIT OR OTHER GUARANTY TO SECURE PAYMENT OF BILLS. THIS AMOUNT SHALL NOT EXCEED TWO-TWELFTH (2/12) OF THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL BILL OF SUCH CUSTOMER OR APPLICANT WHERE BILLS ARE RENDERED MONTHLY, OR THREE-TWELFTH (3/12) OF THE ESTIMATED ANNUAL BILL WHERE BILLS ARE RENDERED BIMONTHLY, OR FOUR-TWELFTHS (4/12) OF THE ANNUAL ESTIMATED ANNUAL BILL WHERE BILLS ARE RENDERED QUARTERLY. INTEREST AT THE RATE OF SIX PERCENT (6%) PER ANNUM WILL BE PAID ON DEPOSITS SO REQUIRED, ACCRUING FROM THE DATE OF DEPOSIT.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

THE UTILITY MAY REFUSE OR DISCONTINUE SERVICE TO AN APPLICANT OR CUSTOMER, AFTER PROPER NOTICE, FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ITS RULES AND REGULATIONS OR STATE AND MUNICIPAL RULES AND REGULATIONS, WHEN A CUSTOMER OR APPLICANT REFUSES OR NEGLECTS TO PROVIDE REASONABLE ACCESS TO THE PREMISES, FOR FRAUDULENT OR ILLEGAL USE OF SERVICE, OR FOR NONPAYMENT OF BILLS. IF DISCONTINUANCE IS FOR NON-PAYMENT OF BILLS, THE CUSTOMER SHALL BE GIVEN A TEN-DAY WRITTEN NOTICE SEPARATE FROM THE ORIGINAL BILL, AND CUT-OFF SHALL BE EFFECTED NOT LESS THAN TWENTY (20) DAYS AFTER THE MAILING DATE OF THE ORIGINAL BILL UNLESS, PRIOR TO DISCONTINUANCE A RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER PRESENTS TO THE UTILITY A WRITTEN CERTIFICATE, SIGNED BY A PHYSICIAN, REGISTERED NURSE, OR PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER, THAT SUCH DISCONTINUANCE WILL AGGRAVATE AN EXISTING ILLNESS OR INFIRMITY ON THE AFFECTED PREMISES, IN WHICH CASE DISCONTINUANCE MAY NOT BE EFFECTED UNTIL THE AFFECTED RESIDENT CAN MAKE OTHER LIVING ARRANGEMENTS OR UNTIL NOT LESS THAN TEN (10) DAYS ELAPSE FROM THE DATE OF THE UTILITY'S NOTIFICATION. WHEN A DANGEROUS CONDITION IS FOUND TO EXIST ON THE CUSTOMER'S OR APPLICANT'S PREMISES, THE SERVICE SHALL BE CUT OFF WITHOUT NOTICE OR REFUSED, provided that the utility notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the discontinuance or refusal and the corrective action to be taken by the applicant or customer before service can be rendered.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

NEW CUSTOMERS AND EXTENSIONS

1. THERE IS A POLICY OF THE MCKINNEY WATER DISTRICT TO SERVE ALL PROPERTY TOUCHING THE LINE THAT CAN BE SERVED BY THE WATER DISTRICT. THE WATER DISTRICT WILL RUN ITS SERVICE LINE TO A POINT OF FIVE FEET INSIDE THE PROPERTY LINE.
2. THE INITIAL HOOK-UP FEE FOR A METER SHALL BE \$225.
3. METERS SHALL BE READ ON OR ABOUT THE 16TH DAY OF EACH MONTH AND BILLS SHALL BE SENT ON OR BEFORE THE 30TH DAY OF EACH MONTH. UPON DELINQUENCY OF TWO MONTHS AND UPON WRITTEN NOTICE THE SERVICE WILL BE DISCONTINUED TO THE CUSTOMER, AND A 10% PENALTY WILL BE ON THE WATER BILL UNLESS THE BILL IS PAID BY THE 15TH DAY OF THE MONTH AFTER THE BILL IS SENT.

WHEREAS, THE LINE HAS A TERMINAL END INTO THE WATER LINE OF THE MCKINNEY WATER ASSOCIATION SO THERE WILL BE NO EXTENSION OF THE ORIGINAL LINE BUT LATERALS MAY BE PLACED ON THE LINE TO SERVE THE AREA SERVICED BY THE ORIGINAL LINE, AND ANY COSTS SHALL BE PAID FROM THE EARNINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION ON THE ISSURANCE OF NEW BONDS. THE WITHIN RULES HAVE BEEN IN EFFECT SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THE ASSOCIATION WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE HOOK-UP COSTS. THE METER AND LINE SHALL REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF THE MCKINNEY WATER DISTRICT, AND EACH INDIVIDUAL USER SHALL HAVE HIS OWN METER OR WHICH A BILL WILL BE SENT.
