The following schedule of water rates and rentals shall be applied and paid in the city of Murray for services rendered by the municipal system:

Twelve cents (12c) per 1000 gallone of water used by City of Murray for commercial purposes. Commercial purposes as herein used shall be interpreted to mean all purposes for which water is used by the City of Murray other than water used through fire hydrants

The City of Murray thall pay \$48.00 per year for each fire hydrant maintained by the City ni Murray for the first one hundred hydrants so maintained. For all fire hydrants maintained over and above the sum of one hundred, the City of Murray shall pay for same at the rate of \$33.60 each per year.
