**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

FOR THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

These Rules and Regulations govern the furnishing of water service by Montgomery County Water District #1 hereinafter referred to as the District and apply to all service received from the District. No employee or individual Commissioner of the District is permitted to make an exception to these Rates, Rules, or Regulations. These Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with the Kentucky Public Service Commission's Rules and Regulations (807 KAR 5:001 - 5:076). The District is subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Kentucky Public Service Commission even though not contained herein.

1. SCOPE

This Schedule of Rules and Regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the District, and applies to all service received from the District whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application, or otherwise. A copy of this schedule, together with a copy of the District's Schedule of Rates and Charges shall be kept open to inspection at the office of the District. The Rules are promulgated under direction and authority granted pursuant to Chapter 5 of Kentucky Administrative Regulations (807 KAR 5). The aforesaid rules and regulations are hereby adopted and included the same as if herein written.

2. REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time by either of the two (2) following methods:

A. By order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission upon formal application by the District, and after hearing as provided by Commission Regulation set for in 807 KAR 5:011.

B. By issuing and filing on at least twenty (20) days notice to the Kentucky Public Service Commission and the Public all proposed changes in the Rules and Regulations, as provided by Commission Regulations set forth in 807 KAR 5:011.
