RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Commissioners have, and will make all policies concerning the North Marshall Water District.
2. The superintendent and office management shall be governed by policies adopted by the Commissioners and shall enforce them impartially
3. All home supplies, such as wells, reservoirs, springs or cisterns shall be disconnected from the public water supply-valves not accepted.
4. There will be a separate meter for each residence.
5. All commercial businesses and multiple housing units must be served by a meter commensurate to volume needed.
6. Meter ownership cannot be transferred from one property owner to another without transferring the property.
7. After a meter is set, it cannot be moved to another location unless the owner pays the relocation cost. This includes raising or lowering meter or meter box, because of landscape changes.
8. A water user who discontinues service between meter readings will be charged 25 cents per 100 gallons used, or the minimum, or more if used. The user at meter reading time will be charged the \$9.50 minimum or more.
9. Water bills become delinquent after the 17th of the billing month. A 10% penalty will then be added to the account.
10. Service will be discontinued after proper notice of intent when the bill is past due, and a \$20.00 re-connect charge plus delinquent bills must be paid before service can be restored. Discontinuance of service for failure to pay will be done in compliance with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 11.
11. When payments are made by bad checks, if the bill is delinquent, service shall be discontinued following proper notification of intent.
12. The consumer is responsible for the maintenance of the area around the meter box location to the extent that the meter may be found and read without the necessity of cutting bushes, vines, etc. It is also the responsibility of the consumer to provide access to meter locations that are beyond fences; gates or stiles are acceptable.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 13. The District may deny service to an applicant who is a member of a delinquent household where the prior customer continues to reside in the household and uses the service.
- 14. When a customer's service is disconnected at one location and then connected at another, the balance due at the original location may be transferred to the account of the new location. The service to the new location may then be disconnected if the customer becomes delinquent in his payment of the original balance.
- 15. North Marshall Water District may require from any customer or applicant for service a minimum cash deposit of an amount not to exceed two twelvths of the estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant.
- 16. Water will be turned off only, when consumer requests such, or for delinquent bills.
- 17. The North Marshall Water District will not guarantee any pressure or flow rate at any fire hydrant. Fire hydrants are installed for use by district personnel for flushing purposes only.
- 18. The Water District is responsible for leaks up to the meter. The user is responsible for all water that flows through the meter.
- 19. The consumer is privileged to read, check or examine his meter at anytime--- however, the District requests the customer replace meter lid to prevent freezing, and to prevent foreign objects getting into the meter box.
- 20. All new services will include a ball valve outside of the meter box for customers use. The yoke valve inside of the meter box is for Water District personnel use only.
- 21. Water service can be discontinued permanently at any time by the consumers written request; however, his tap fee will be forfeited.
- 22. The Water District will serve any individual outside of the District's service area in accordance with 807-KAR 5:066, Section 12 of the rules and regulations of the P.S.C.
- 23. The Water District will discontinue service to vacated or winterized property upon request and the meter will be removed from the meter box, however, a \$20.00 re-connect charge will be made when service is restored.
