RULES AND REGULATIONS

These rules and regulations are intended to supplement all bond resolutions, the rate resolutions and By-laws which have been enacted by the district, and which are incorporated by reference.

- 1. Meters will be read monthly between the 15th and 24th of each month.
2. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first of each month. Said bills will state that they are to be paid within 15 days.
3. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission from district on the property to be served.
4. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and his decisions may be appealed to the district commission within 10 days.
5. The principal place of business of the district will be c/o Stallard Smith, Shelbyville, Kentucky.
6. Water bills may be paid at c/o District Manager, District Office, Shelbyville, Ky.
7. The district shall serve all customers on the line in the district unless the district deems it unfeasible to serve such customer based on the district's determination that the present or future flow or pressure at the requested point of service will be unsatisfactory.
8. In addition to standard connection fees, the district can require any developer of more than one lot (subdivider) or potential large user to furnish storage or pumping facilities or to enlarge supply lines or to guarantee payment of a minimum bill over a period of years by special contract.
9. The customer cannot give away or resell water without the written consent of the district.
10. Each house must be metered separately, unless the written consent of the district to do otherwise is obtained.
11. Regulatory provisions of the rate resolutions, bylaws, if any, and bond ordinances are made a part of this rate resolution.
12. No residence shall be served through a Field Connection, if Field Connections are authorized by the rate tariff.
13. The district does not guarantee either pressure or flow on any fire hydrant nor the working condition of any such fire hydrant.
14. These rules may be amended by the district commission.
15. Subdivision refunding agreements based on a refund of water bills over a period of ten years can be established to pay up to all subdivision extension costs.
