RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service commission.
2. Any resident or business of West McCracken Water District is eligible for water service from the District, providing a water main is within 50 feet of his property line. The District may require that the prospective customer contract to use service for one (1) year or more and provide guarantee for such service. Any extensions of greater than fifty (50) feet or extensions to a proposed real estate subdivision shall be in conformance with 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12.
- (T) 3. Water service will be terminated within 24 hours after receiving a written request from the customer requesting discontinuance. Request for discontinuance may also be made in person. Water service will be terminated by phone provided customer gives their Social Security Number. The West McCracken Water District Office Hours are: 1st thru 10th of month, 8:00 AM to Noon and 1:00 PM to 4:30 PM, then 11th thru 15th of the month 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM, closed Saturdays.
- (T) 4. Customer complaints concerning the District's service should be made in person or by phone during the previously stated office hours. The next page contains the customer complaint form used by the District.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

5. The District may require any applicant for service to pay a cash deposit to assure payment of bills. This deposit will be based on average bills of similar customers in the District. This deposit shall not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such customer.

The District shall place the deposits in a special account where interest is allowed to compound. Interest gained on the deposits shall be refunded or credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis.

If the District retains a customer's deposit for more than eighteen (18) months, the District shall notify the customer in writing that, at the customer's request, the deposit will be re-calculated every eighteen (18) months based on the customer's actual usage. If the deposit on account with the District differs by more than ten dollars (\$10.00) for residential customers, or by more than ten percent (10%) for non-residential customers, from the deposit calculated from actual usage, then the District shall refund any over payment and may collect any under payment by a credit or an addition to the customer's bill.

The District requires a customer applying for service to sign a Contract For Water Service. A copy of this Contract is contained on the next page.

- 7. The customer shall be responsible for all plumbing, including a back flow preventer, installed on his property beginning at the outlet side of the water meter, said installation to be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Kentucky Department of Health.
- 8. No customer shall resell water except under the terms of a special contract executed with the District.
- 9. No connections to the water pipes of the system shall be made except by or under the supervision of a duly authorized officer, agent or employee of the system.
- (N) 10. A. All services shall be metered with the exception of approved fire sprinkler systems.
B. Fire approved sprinkler systems shall be charged in the following manner:

For a 3" line	\$20.00 per month
For a 4" line	\$25.00 per month
For a 6" line	\$30.00 per month
For a 8" line	\$40.00 per month
- 11. The District will not furnish free water to any person for any purpose.
- (T) 12. In the installation of a service line, the customer shall leave the trench open and pipe uncovered until it is inspected by the District and shown to be free from any tee, branch connection, irregularity, or defect. This inspection may be waived if the service line is installed by a licensed plumber.

(T) 13. The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs or other reasons.

No person shall be entitled to damages nor a payment refund for any interruption of service which, in the opinion of the District, was deemed necessary.

The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruptions of service, and when such interruptions occur, service will be reestablished with the shortest possible delay. When service is interrupted, all customers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever possible.

14. Meters are read each month beginning on the 20th day of the month.

15. Customers are billed each month on the first day of the month.

16. Bills are payable on or before the 10th day of each month. If bills are not paid within 15 days of date of billing, a penalty of 10% of the bill shall be added. Service will be discontinued if bills are not paid by the 20th day of the month. Five (5) days written notice will be given to customers before service is discontinued. An extension of 30 days is given a customer for an unpaid bill if a case of hardship is indicated.

(I) A fee of \$20.00 shall be required to reestablish discontinued service during office hours. A fee of \$35.00 shall be required after office hours, holidays and weekends. This includes reestablishing service which was voluntarily discontinued and reestablishing service which was disconnected for non-payment of bills. The District shall require payment of all delinquent water bills including penalties, in full before reconnection is made.

(N) A fee of \$20.00 shall be required to transfer services to a new buyer.

(N) A fee of \$15.00 shall be required for a special meter reading at the customers request, and the second meter reading shows the original reading.

I understand that adjustments are figured by the difference between my average water bill and the bill that reflects the leak. The adjustment is then based on West McCracken Water District assuming 50% of the loss and I am responsible for the other 50% of the loss plus my average bill. I further understand that even though an adjustment is to be considered, I am still responsible for the bill and that should I be disconnected for non-payment, the entire amount plus \$10.00 reconnect fee must be paid before service will be restored and any adjustment made will be credited to my account.

I also understand that during the lifetime of my water service line, only two leak adjustments will be permitted. Each of these adjustments may cover a maximum of two billing periods. Before a third adjustment can be considered, the entire water service line from the meter box to my house or structure must be replaced and that I must submit evidence of this fact before the third adjustment is given. If plastic pipe is used for any repair of underground water service lines, it must be no less than class 160 p.s.i., either C.T.S. or I.P.S. pipe. THE USE OF RADIATOR CLAMPS, KING NIPPLES, OR THE EQUIVALENT CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

I realize that no adjustment will be made until this form (completed in its entirety, signed and dated) and my plumber's statement are returned to West McCracken Water District.

I hereby verify that I have read the information given above and that all statements are true and correct, and that the excess usage in my plumbing system has now been corrected.

(T) 20. Multiple Services

A. Permanent Single Family Dwellings.

Under no circumstances shall more than one permanent single family residential dwelling be provided service through a single meter.

B. Commercial Trailer Park.

(1) Definition. A commercial trailer park shall be defined as two (2) or more units occupying a common parcel of land and producing revenue of two (2) or more units designated as a trailer park by the Kentucky Department Health for reasons of health and public welfare.

(2) Minimum Bill. Rates set forth herein are based on the capacity, of the trailer park whether filled or not. For purposes of determining the park capacity, the park owner shall submit a plat of development to the District. Payment for water purchased shall be 50% of the regular residential minimum times the number of trailer spaces available (includes 50% of residential minimum gallonage times number of spaces available). Balance of usage billed at regular residential rate schedule.

(3) Meter Size. The utility shall determine the size of meter necessary to provide adequate services and the meter installation shall be paid for by the customer at the prescribed rate in effect. The following schedule of meter sizes and maximum number of trailer spaces shall be adopted as the basis for selection by the Water District under normal conditions:

Any additional charge for increasing the meter size at some future date shall be paid by the owner at the actual cost to the utility less any salvage value for the meter removed.

Anyone desiring service under the commercial trailer park regulation shall not serve a residential home or homes without paying a full minimum bill for such residential home.

C. Multi-Family Dwellings

(1) Definition. A multi-family dwelling shall be defined as a permanent structure housing two or more families and producing revenue. Included in this definition are duplex, tri-plex, and apartment buildings.

(2) Minimum Bill. Rates set forth herein are based on the unit capacity of the structure whether filled or not. Payment for water purchased shall be based upon the total consumption registered by the meter per month divided by the number of dwelling units available and each shall be billed at the regular residential rate structure for its pro-rate share as if each unit were an individual customer.

D. Other Combinations

Multiple service for a permanent single family residential dwelling in combination with trailer homes, and trailer homes not otherwise classified as a commercial trailer park may be served from a single meter. In such cases, the total consumption registered by the meter per month will be divided by the number of dwelling units being served and each shall be billed at the regular residential rates for his pro-rate share as if he were an individual customer.

(T) 21. Extension of Main.

A. Normal Extension.

An extension of fifty feet or less along an existing road shall be made by the West McCracken Water District to its existing distribution main without charge for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one year or more and provide a guarantee for such service.

B. Other Extensions.

(1) When an extension of the West McCracken Water District's main to serve an applicant or group of applicants amounts to more than fifty feet per applicant, the District may require the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty feet per customer to be deposited with the District by the applicant or the applicants, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension. Cost of the total extension shall be established from accurate records of construction cost by the District, including materials, labor, supervision, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other cost incurred by the District and made available to the applicant or applicants receiving service.

B. Other Extensions. (Continued)

(2) Each customer receiving service under such extension will be reimbursed under the following plan: Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, which for the purpose of rule shall be the refund period, the West McCracken Water District shall refund to the customer or customers who paid for the excessive footage, the cost of fifty feet of the extension in place for each additional customer connected during the year whose service line is directly connected to the extension installed and not to extensions or laterals therefrom; but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid the District. After the end of the refund period, (10 Years) no refund will be made.

C. Extension To a Real Estate Subdivision.

(1) Applicants Cost of Extension. An applicant desiring an extension to a real estate subdivision will initially be required to deposit a minimum of \$500,00 with the District prior to the development of preliminary construction drawings and cost estimate by the District's authorized engineering representative. If after the development of this preliminary information, the applicant withdraws the application for the real estate subdivision extension, the excess deposit over and above the actual administrative costs incurred by the District on the extension up to the time of withdrawal will be refunded to the applicant. Should the applicant desire to continue with the extension, the District may require the total estimated cost of the extension to be deposited with the District by the applicant. The preliminary costs incurred by the District and the initial deposit paid by the applicant will be included in the total estimated costs and total required deposit, respectively. The cost of the total extension shall be established from accurate records of construction cost by the District, including materials, labor, supervision, engineering, testing, disinfection, water and such other costs incurred by the District. Records of cost shall be maintained by the District and made available to the applicant receiving service. If after

the construction of the extionsion, the actual cost of the extension is less than the total amount deposited by the applicant, the excess shall be refunded to the applicant. If the actual total cost of the extension is greater than the total amount deposited with the District by the applicant, an amount equal to the excess in cost shall be deposited with the District prior to the District's final acceptance of the extension.

(2) Applicants Reimbursed for Cost of Extension.

Each year for a period of not less than ten (10) years, the West McCracken Water District shall refund to the applicant who paid for the extension a sum equivalent to the cost of fifty (50) feet of the extension installed for each additional customer connected during the year but in no case shall the total amount refunded exceed the amount paid to the District. After the end of the refund period from the completion of the extension (10 years), no refund will be required to be made.

D. Construction Procedure.

(1) Extensions by Water District. Water line extensions extended to customers under Item (A) Normal Extension; (B) Subdivision, shall be installed by the Water District's forces, or by a competent contractor employed by the Water District or by the person or persons desiring service and approved in writing by the District.

(2) Construction Drawings. Plans and specifications for proposed extensions shall be prepared by the West McCracken Water District's authorized engineering representative shall comply with the District's standards, shall meet the requirements of the Kentucky Department of Health, the Public Service Commission and other applicable federal, state, and local regulating agencies.

(3) Real Estate Subdivision Plats. A reproducible plat of a real estate subdivision as recorded in the County Court Clerk's office shall be furnished by the developer for use by the District's Engineer in laying out the proposed water lines.

(4) Utility Easements. Water mains shall generally be laid in a 15 foot permanent easement on private property. A 15 foot temporary construction easement adjacent to the 15 foot permanent easement shall also be required where practical, from each private property owner. The cost of obtaining easements shall be included in the cost of construction as set forth in items 21B and 21C above.

(5) Service Lines and Service Connection Charges. Meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter will be installed by the Water District as required to customers adjacent to said main extensions, and the Water District shall be reimbursed for this service by the property owner in the form of a Service Connection Charge current at the time the service is made not withstanding the following:

- a. The District may under certain circumstances, alter Service Connection Charges to exceed the standard Service Connection Charges in effect for the purposes of reimbursement to applicants desiring extensions under Item 21B, Other Extensions, and item 21C, Extensions to a Real Estate Subdivision, if said altered Service Connection Charges are approved by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Public Service Commission.

(6) Potable Water-Maintenance of Lines. After the mains have been installed, tested, and chlorinated to the satisfaction of the Health Department, the West McCracken Water District shall then accept the responsibility for furnishing potable water to the extension and for maintenance of the lines including meters, meter boxes and service lines from the main to the meter.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed to prohibit the West McCracken Water District from making extensions under different arrangements provided such arrangements have been approved by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Public Service Commission.

F. Extensions by the West McCracken Water District.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as to prohibit the West McCracken Water District from making at its expense greater extensions than herein prescribed, should its judgement so dictate, provided like free extensions are made to other customers under similar conditions.
