Whereas, the Purchaser is organized and established under the provisions of; \_\_\_\_\_ of the  
Code of Kentucky Revised Statutes, for the purpose of constructing and operating a water supply distribution  
system serving water users within the area described in plans now on file in the office of the Purchaser and to accomplish  
this purpose, the Purchaser will require a supply of treated water, and

Whereas, the Seller owns and operates a water supply distribution system with a capacity currently capable of serving the  
present customers of the Seller's system and the estimated number of water users to be served by the said Purchaser as shown  
in the plans of the system now on file in the office of the Purchaser, and

Whereas, by motion unanimously adopted No. \_\_\_\_\_ enacted on the \_\_\_\_\_ day  
of October, 19 77, by the Seller, the sale of water to the Purchaser in accordance  
with the provisions of the said motion was approved, and the execution of this contract  
carrying out the said motion by the Chairman  
and attested by the Secretary, was duly authorized, and

Whereas, by resolution of the Commissioners  
of the Purchaser, enacted on the 11th day of October, 19 77,  
the purchase of water from the Seller in accordance with the terms set forth in the said resolution  
was approved, and the execution of this contract by the Chairman of said Commission PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION  
attested by the Secretary was duly authorized; OF KENTUCKY, and  
EFFECTIVE

Now, therefore, in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual agreements hereinafter set forth,

A. The Seller Agrees:

1. (Quality and Quantity) To furnish the Purchaser at the point of delivery hereinafter specified, 10,000,000 gallons of  
this contract or any renewal or extension thereof, potable treated water meeting applicable purity standards of the Real  
Kentucky Department of Health PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 50.1  
SECTION 9 (1)  
FOR THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

in such quantity as may be required by the Purchaser not to exceed 10,000,000 gallons per month.
