RATES AND CHARGES

TARIFF AS TO INCREASE IN WHOLESALE WATER RATE

KRS 278.015(2) AND 807 KAR 5:068 provides essentially the manner in which a Water District may implement a Purchase Water Adjustment designed to recover the actual cost of water purchased by a Water District from a wholesale supplier.

The Allen County Water District purchases substantially all of its water from the Glasgow Water and Sewer Commission of Glasgow, Kentucky. By its Ordinance No. 2633, the City of Glasgow, Kentucky, established new rates for the Glasgow Water and Sewer Commission to charge increased new wholesale rates to be charged to its customers, including the Allen County Water District, effective July 1, 2008 (\$1.40 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.75 per 1,000 gallons) AND effective July 1, 2009 (\$1.75 per 1000 gallons to \$1.95 per 1,000 gallons). A copy of said Ordinance is attached hereto as a part hereof.

The Allen County Water District was notified of this increase by a letter from the Glasgow Water Company, dated May 16, 2008. A copy of said letter is filed herewith as a part hereof.

By Letter to the Allen County Water District from its Engineer, Kenvirons, Inc., dated July 25, 2008, the Water District t was informed as follows:

"The indication is that the district could absorb the increased purchased water cost relative to the \$1.75 per thousand gallons rated along with the adjustments to the 2007 expenses. Next year the rate will increase to \$1.95. Based on the same parameters, the purchased water cost will increase an additional \$69,092, which would cause a negative net income of approximately \$41,000. The above calculations do not consider any customer growth, which would generate a small amount of additional revenues. The conclusion is that the district would absorb the initial \$1.75 per thousand rate, but not the \$1.95 that is proposed to be effective next year. The \$1.75 rate results in an increase in customer rate of \$0.41 per thousand gallons. The \$1.95 rate result in an additional \$0.23 per thousand gallons for a total of \$0.64 per thousand gallons."

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RATES AND CHARGES

The current wholesale base rate of the City of Glasgow is \$1.75 per thousand gallons. The changed rate of the City of Glasgow is \$1.95 per thousand gallons, effective July 1, 2009, as shown on the City of Glasgow's Ordinance No. 2633.

The twelve month period upon which the purchased water adjustment is April, 2008 through March, 2009.

Gallons purchased by Allen County Water District from City of Glasgow during the 12 month period is 347,791,400; from the City of Scottsville is 8,943,800; a total of 356,735,200 gallons.

Total gallons sold by Allen County Water District for the 12 month period is 295,078,700.

The annual increased water cost is \$69,558.28 [347,791,400 gallons x \$0.20 per 1000 gallons = \$69,558.28]. (\$1.95 less \$1.75 = \$0.20)

The purchased water adjustment factor is, therefore, \$0.24 per 1000 gallons (\$69,558.28 divided by 295,078.700 gallons = \$0.24 per 1000 gallons)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- d) Meter Test Charge: Will be assessed when a customer requests the utility perform a test on the customer's meter to check for accuracy, and the test shows the customer's meter is not more than two percent (2%) fast.
- e) Reconnection Charge: Will be assessed to reconnect service that has been terminated for non-payment of service or for violation of Utility or Public Service Commission rules and regulations, and will include the cost of the service trip for both the disconnection and the reconnection.
- f) Returned Check Charge: Will be assessed to any customer whose personal check is returned due to insufficient funds or other reason for which the customer is responsible. Any customer who presents during any 12-month period two personal checks that are subsequently returned for insufficient funds or other reason for which the customer is responsible must make payment in the form of cash, money order or cashier's check for the 12 months following the presentment of the second returned check. During this 12-month period, the utility may refuse to accept from such customer any payment made in the form of personal check. In the event that a customer's payment is refused for the reasons stated above, the utility may consider the bill as unpaid and may exercise its right to disconnect service for nonpayment of bills, per procedures set forth in the Termination of Service policy of this tariff and in accordance with Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:006, Section 14.
- g) Service Call/Investigation Charge: Will be assessed when a customer requests the onsite presence of utility personnel to investigate a service problem and the problem is a result of the customer's own plumbing facilities, beyond the utility's delivery point, or not caused by failure of utility facilities. Any maintenance and repair of facilities beyond the utility's delivery point is the responsibility of the customer.
