RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Utility Regulatory Commission.
2. Any resident or business of Barkley Lake Water District is eligible for water service from the District providing a water main is within 50 feet of his property line.
3. Water service will be terminated within 24 hours after receiving request from customer requesting discontinuance.
4. All applications for service shall be accompanied by a \$20.00 deposit to assure payment of the bill.
5. All applications for service shall be accompanied by a tap-on fee in the following amounts:

RULES AND REGULATIONS

6. The customer shall be responsible for all plumbing installed on his property beginning at the outlet side of the meter, said installation to be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Kentucky Department of Health. Under no circumstances shall any cross connection between water or drainage systems be allowed to exist.
7. No customer shall resell water except under the terms of a special contract executed with the District.
8. All services shall be metered.
9. The District shall not furnish free water to any person for any reason.
10. A fee of \$20.00 shall be charged for re-establishing discontinued service.
11. No connections to the water pipes of the system shall be made except by or under the supervision of a duly authorized official, agent or employee of the District.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

12. If the water service of any customer is discontinued for the nonpayment of bills, the District shall require payment of a \$20.00 reconnection fee and payment of all delinquent water bills, including penalties, in full before reconnection is made.
13. All meters shall be read by the customer prior to the 20th day of each month and the meter reading returned with payment of the previous billing.
14. Bills for the previous month shall be rendered on or about the 5th day of the month following and shall be due and payable upon receipt. If the bill remains unpaid through the 20th day of the month, the account shall be deemed delinquent and a 10% penalty shall be added.
15. An account remaining delinquent 30 days shall be subject to discontinuance of service and a 10% penalty shall be added to the base bill.
16. Customers failing to return meter readings shall be billed for the average usage for the previous 12 months.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

17. Meters shall be check-read by District personnel periodically. Any discrepancy between the actual meter reading as determined by District personnel and that reported by the customer shall be reconciled by dividing the difference between the observed and reported meter readings by the number of months since the meter was last check-read. The average amount of discrepancy thus determined shall then be added to or subtracted from each month's consumption during the period in question and each bill adjusted accordingly.
18. In the event a customer's consumption increases due to a leak, his bill will be adjusted to a charge of ^{86¢}~~50¢~~ per 1,000 gallons for all water over twice his average monthly consumption over the 3 months immediately preceding the discovery of the leak. It shall be the customer's responsibility to repair any leak immediately upon discovery and only one bill will be adjusted.
