Applicable Within the Service area of Beech Grove Water Water System, Inc.

These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission

Any resident of Beech Grove Water System, Inc., is eligible for water service from the District.

A fee of \$10.00 shall be paid per membership.

A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for reinstalling of services.

One (1) week's notice must be given the company to discontinue service or change of occupancy.


Bills are due when rendered and delinquent after ten (10) days; if not paid within thirty (30) days, service may be discontinued by company.

Meters will be read and bills rendered monthly, but the company reserves the right to vary the dates or length of period covered.

~~Water connection and installation fees for each customer will be \$100.00 - \$200.00 after completion of construction.~~

A charge of \$1.00 will be made for each meter for each turn-on or cut-off, other than change of occupancy.

Service lines to meters and meters are property of the company. From meter to customer outlet installation and service will be sole responsibility of customer.

RATES AND CHARGES

The utility may require a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills as set forth in 807 KAR 5:006 Section 7. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the required deposit.

All customers within a particular customer classification will pay equal deposits. The amount shall not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual bill of customers within said classification where bills are rendered monthly.

Interest, as prescribed by KRS 278.460, will be paid annually either by refund or credit to the customer's bill, except that no refund or credit will be made if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary date of the deposit.

Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.

If a deposit is held longer than 18 months, the deposit will be recalculated at the customer's request based on the customer's actual usage.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

EXPLANATION OF SPECIAL CHARGES

- A. Purpose: Pursuant to the provisions of 807 KAR 5:006, Section 8, the District has adopted the following Special Charges to cover certain costs incurred for a specific customer. The purpose of these Special Charges is to keep from increasing rates to other customers who do not receive any benefits from the service provided or the action taken.

- B. Special Charges:
 - 1. Turn-On Charge. A Turn-On Charge shall be assessed for a new service Turn-On, seasonal Turn-On or temporary service. A Turn-On Charge shall not be made for initial installation of service where a tap-fee is applicable.

 - 2. Reconnect Charge. A Reconnect Charge shall be assessed to reconnect a service which has been terminated for non-payment of bills or violation of the District's Rules and Regulations or the Public Service Commission's Regulations.

 - 3. Termination or Field Collection Charge. A charge shall be assessed when a District representative makes a trip to the premises of a customer for the purpose of terminating service. The charge shall be assessed if the District representative actually terminates service or if, in the course of the trip, the customer pays the delinquent bill to avoid termination. The charge shall also be made if the District representative agrees to delay termination based on the customer's agreement to pay the delinquent bill by a specific date. The District shall make a Termination or Field Collection Charge only once in any billing period.

- 4. **Meter Resetting Charge.** A charge shall be assessed for resetting a meter if the meter has been removed at the customer's request.
- 5. **Meter Test Charge** This charge shall be assessed if a customer requests the meter be tested pursuant to Section 18 of 807 KAR 5:006 and the test shows the meter is not more than two percent (2%) fast. No charge shall be made if the test shows the meter is more than two percent (2%) fast.
- ~~6. **Return Check Charge.** A Returned Check Charge shall be assessed if a check accepted for payment of a water bill is not honored by the customer's financial institution.~~
- 7. **Late Payment Penalty.** A penalty shall be assessed if a customer fails to pay a bill for services by the due date shown on the customer's bill. The penalty shall be assessed only once on any bill for rendered services. Any payment received shall first be applied to the bill for service rendered. Additional penalty charges shall not be assessed on unpaid penalty charges.

C. The amount of each Special Charge shall be the amount approved by the Public Service Commission. These amounts are set forth elsewhere in this Tariff.

RULES & REGULATIONS

FIRE DEPARTMENTS:

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district ("User") may withdraw water from the utility's water distribution system for the purpose of fighting fires or training firefighters at no charge on the condition that it maintains estimates of the amount of water used for fire protection and training during the calendar month and reports the amount of this water usage to the utility no later than the 15th day of the following calendar month.

Any city, county, urban-county, charter county, fire protection district, or volunteer fire protection district that withdraws water from the utility's water distribution system for fire protection or training purposes and fails to submit the required report on water usage in a timely manner shall be assessed the cost of this water.

A non-reporting user's usage shall be presumed to 0.3 percent of the utility's total water sales for the calendar month. A non-reporting user may present evidence of its actual usage to rebut the presumed usage. The utility shall consider this evidence and may adjust the presumed usage amount accordingly.

The non-reporting user shall be billed for this usage at the lowest usage block rate regardless of customer classification that the utility charges.

A non-reporting user shall also be assessed a penalty of \$ 10.00 for each failure to submit a report in a timely manner.

WATER USER'S AGREEMENT

Beech Grove Water System Inc.

NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

Beech Grove, Kentucky

THIS AGREEMENT, Between the Beech Grove Water System Inc. a non-profit corporation (hereinafter called corporation), organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Kentucky, and

_____ a member of the corporation, (hereinafter called members).

WITNESS:

WHEREAS, the member desires to purchase water for domestic, farm, and other purposes, from the corporation, and to enter into a water user's agreement as required by the by-laws of the corporation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, it is hereby understood and agreed.

The corporation shall furnish, subject to the limitation hereinafter provided for, such quantity of water for domestic, farm, and other purposes, as the member desire and in connection with his occupancy of the following described property.

The member shall maintain at his own expense a service line, which shall begin at his property line and extend to the dwelling and other portions of his premises.

The member's service line shall connect with the distribution system of the corporation as the nearest place desired use by the member, provided the corporation has determined that the corporation's system is of sufficient capacity to permit delivery of water at that point.

The members shall pay for such water at such rates; the corporation shall determine time and place.

The corporation shall purchase and install a cut-off valve and may also include a water meter, in each service. Such cut-off valve and meter shall be installed at a point agreed upon between the user and the corporation, on the corporation's distribution system. The corporation shall have exclusive right to use such cut-off valve and water meter and to turn it on and off.

The corporation shall have a final jurisdiction in any question of location of any service line connection to its distribution system; shall determine the allocation of water to members in the event of a water shortage; may shut off the water to a member who allows a connection or extension to be made to his service line for the purpose of supplying water to another user.

The failure of a member to pay water charges duly imposed shall result in the automatic imposition of the following penalties:

- Non-payment within (2) two days form the due date will be subject to a penalty of (10) ten percent of the delinquent account.
- Non-payment within (13) thirteen days from the due date will result in the water being shut off for the member's property.
- Non-payment for (30) thirty days after original due date will allow the corporation, in addition to all other rights and remedies to purchase the member's Membership Certificate and terminate the membership and, in such event the member shall not be entitled to receive, nor the corporation obligated to supply, any water under the agreement.
- In the event it becomes necessary for the corporation to shut off the water from a member's property a fee of **\$50.00** will be charged for reconnection of the service.
