RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations govern the furnishing of water service by the Crittenden - Livingston County Water District, subject to change by the District at any time, subject to approval of the Public Service Commission through the filing of revised tariff sheets with the PSC.

- A. All taps and connections to the mains of the District shall be made by and/or under the direction and supervision of District personnel.
- B. Water service may be discontinued by the District for, upon 10 days' written notice (except that in the event of a violation under Item 7 below, water service may be terminated immediately), any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition, and especially for any of the following reasons:
 - 1. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 - 2. Failure to report to the District additions to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
 - 3. Resale of water.
 - 4. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep such pipes in a suitable state of repair.
 - 5. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or ~~valve~~ ^{PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION} ~~allowing~~ ^{KENTUCKY} permitting such tampering by others. ^{EFFECTIVE}
 - 6. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separate water supply to premises which receive water from the District. ^{MAR 01 1985}

7. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, with reference to the continuation of water service, water service shall be cut off without notice or shall be refused, provided the District shall notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the discontinuance or refusal and the corrective action to be taken by the applicant or customer before service can be restored.

C. Any customer desiring to discontinue the water service to his premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in person or in writing at the business office of the District at least three (3) days prior to the date on which the customer desires to discontinue service, and the customer shall not be liable for water consumed beyond the date of discontinuance stated in such notice; if such notice in person or in writing is not given, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered to such premises by the District until such notice is received by the District.

D. Bills and notice relating to the conduct of the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the user's agreement unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from the payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.

E. 1. Meters shall be read bi-monthly on or about the 25th of the month. Bills for water service are due and payable at the office of the District, or any designated agent, on the date of bi-monthly issue. Bills for water service in Crittenden County will be dated and mailed on the first working day of each even numbered month. Bills for water service in Livingston County will be dated and mailed on the first working day of each odd numbered month. The past due date shall be the tenth day after the date of bi-monthly issue.

2. All bills not paid on or before the past due date shall be deemed delinquent. When a bill has been delinquent for a period of twenty days, the District shall serve a customer a written final notice of said delinquency, and of the intent of the District to discontinue service ten days after the date of such notice unless such bill is paid prior to the expiration of such ten days. If a delinquent bill is not paid within ten days after date of such final notice (thirty days from past due date), the water supply to the customer may be discontinued without further notice; provided, however, if, prior to discontinuance of service, there is delivered to the District, or to its employee empowered to discontinue service, a written certificate signed by a physician, a registered nurse, or a public health officer that, in the opinion of the certifier, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until ten (10) days elapse from the time of the District's receipt of said certification, whichever comes first.

F. Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$25.00 will be made for reconnection of water service, but the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed by the customer to the District have been paid.

G. The District reserves the right to request that a nominal amount be placed on deposit with the District for the purpose of establishing or maintaining any customer's credit, such amount not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such customer. Upon the payment of such deposit, the District shall issue to such customer a certificate of deposit, showing the name of the customer, the location of the initial premises occupied by the customer, and the date and amount of the deposit. The District will pay to such customer interest on such deposit at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, until such deposit is reimbursed to the customer.

H. All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the District, and the District reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12 and 13.

I. It shall be the policy of the District to test each water meter at least once every five years. In addition, upon written request of any customer, the meter serving such customer shall be tested by the District. Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within 12 months preceding the requested test; otherwise, a charge of \$2.00 will be made and then only if the test indicates meter accuracy within the limits of 2%.

If a meter is inaccurate in excess of 2%, whether upon periodic testing or upon requested testing, additional tests shall be made at once to determine the average error of the meter, and the adjustments shall be made in the customer's water bills as follows:

1. If the result of such tests shows an average error greater than 2% fast, the customer's bill for the period during which the meter error is known to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. If the period during which the meter error existed cannot be determined, then the customer's bill shall be recomputed for one-half (1/2) of the elapsed time since the last previous test, but in no event to exceed 12 months; provided, however, that if time for the periodic test has overrun to the extent that 1/2 of the time elapsed since the last previous test exceeds 12 months, the refund shall be for the 12 months specified above, plus those months exceeding the periodic test period; provided, further, that such refund may be limited to the 12 month period if failure to make the periodic test was due to causes beyond the control of the District.

If the result of such tests shows an average error greater than 2% slow, the customer's bill for the period during which the meter error is known to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. If the period during which the meter error existed cannot be determined, then the customer's bill shall be recomputed for one-half (1/2) of the elapsed time since the last previous test, but in no event to exceed 12 months.
- 3. If the result of such tests necessitates making a refund or back billing a customer, the customer shall be notified in writing of the percentage of error, fast or slow, the date(s) of testing, and the amount of charge or credit to be shown on the next bill of the customer.
- J. Where a meter has ceased to register, or meter reading could not be obtained, the quantity of water consumed will be based upon an average of the prior six months' consumption and the conditions of water service prevailing during the period in which the meter failed to register.
- K. The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and when such interruptions occur will endeavor to reestablish service with the shortest possible delay. When the service is interrupted all consumers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.
- L. The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of the breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs. No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the District may be deemed necessary.

M. Customer having boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the District must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the stream line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice.

N. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the District.

O. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.

P. (1) An extension of fifty (50) feet or less to the District's distribution main shall be made without charge (other than the prescribed standard connections charge) for a prospective customer who shall apply for and contract to use service for one (1) year or more and who provides a guarantee for such service.

(2) For each extension of the District's service line in excess of fifty (50) feet, the District shall require the customer to whose premises such extension is made to deposit with the District the total cost of the excessive footage over fifty (50) feet, based on the average estimated cost per foot of the total extension. Such deposit may be refundable to the customer in certain instances, in accordance with Title 807 KAR 5.066, KY Section 12(2)(b).

Q. If any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or other injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customer, member of his household, his agent, or employee, as determined by a court of law having jurisdiction over the parties, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District, and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer.

R. Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell the water to any other person.

S. All customers shall grant or convey, or shall cause to be granted or conveyed, to the District a perpetual easement and right of way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said easement or right of way is necessary for the District water facilities and lines to be able to furnish service to the customer.

T. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system whose decision may be appealed to the Commission of the District within ten days; otherwise, the operator's decision will be final. Complaints may also be registered with the Public Service Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12 and 13.

U. WATER MAIN EXTENSION POLICY

1. Authorization

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2/1/2006*

No water mains, extensions, or appurtenances shall be installed or connected to the distribution system except in accordance with regulations established by the Crittenden-Livingston County Water District.

2. Applications for Extensions

The installation of water main extensions to serve new customers shall be considered by the District upon request by the customer(s) or developer of a new subdivision. The District may require an application signed by the customers and the developer before the District shall proceed with an analysis and estimate of the proposed new water main extension.

3. Design and Construction

In order to assure an adequate supply of water, the design and construction of water mains and appurtenances shall be under the control and direct supervision to the District. Such control shall include determination of the size and type of pipe and selection of points in connection to the existing system. Extensions must be connected at not less than one point with existing lines of equal or greater size and have sufficient capacity to serve the extension, even though this requires bypassing or paralleling other existing mains. The minimum size of pipe used in the extension will be dictated by the demand of the new customers or may be set by the Commissioners, larger sizes may be required if so determined by the District. In all cases, the design shall be at least equal to the standards established by good engineering practices for water districts.

4. Cost of Extensions

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2/11/2006

a. The cost of extensions shall be paid by the applicants. The District will make an estimate of cost for each extension, which shall be the basis for initial payment to the District. This cost shall be exclusive of the meter connections. The District shall pay that portion of the cost of the water main extension equal to 50 feet for each applicant for service. That part of the cost not covered by the District's portion shall be contributed by those applicants desiring service on the main extension. Each applicant will also be required to pay the District's approved "Tap-on-fee" for a meter connection to the main extension. Upon completion of the work, a final determination of the actual cost will be made by the District and any necessary adjustment made of funds so contributed.

b. The cost of extensions shall include all items of material, labor, engineering, and general office expense pertaining to the preparation of drawings and specifications, and the purchase, storage, delivery, and installation of pipe, valves, and all accessories, including any extraordinary costs occasioned by the opening of pavement, unusual soil conditions, frost, obstructions, or other cause. It shall also include the cost of any portion of the extension constructed parallel to existing mains of insufficient capacity to support the extension, considered by the District to be presently adequate for the services of abutting properties, whether or not such properties are actually being served.

c. The cost of the extension will not include costs for any portion of the extension which abuts property presently served by connections to existing mains considered unsatisfactory by the District for the connected load, provided the extension will make unnecessary any improvements to the existing main which would otherwise be required, except that the front footage cost so excluded shall not exceed 250 feet for each such service.

In the event the District elects to install a main larger than would be recommended by the engineers or than would be necessary to meet the applicants estimated requirements, in order to strengthen the distribution system or to provide capacity for further extensions, cost will not include the estimated difference in cost between the size pipe required and that actually installed.

5. Refunds to Contributors

a. Property owners (non customers who are property owners on the main extension may also contribute yet choose not to have a meter connected) or developers who contribute funds toward the financing of main extensions will be eligible to receive refunds on their contribution when additional consumers (customers) are served from the extension within a period of six (6) years after execution of a main extension agreement between the District and the contributors.

b. For the purpose of refund, an additional customer shall be defined as one who satisfies the following conditions:

1. His service must be connected to the new main or to a parallel main considered adequate for such connection by reason of the strengthening effect of the new main.
2. He shall not have been previously served at his present premises by other existing mains.
3. He shall not have contributed to the initial investment in the main.
4. His property shall not have been included in a contributor's development.

c. Before additional customers are permitted service connections, they will be required to deposit (pay) with the District their contribution to the cost of that water main extension.

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2/12/2009

d. For a period of six (6) years after the original acceptance and execution of agreement with the original applicants of the main extension, each additional customer directly connected to each particular extension will be required to contribute to the cost of that water main extension based on a recomputation of both the District's portion of the total cost and each customer's contribution as set out under cost of extensions. The District shall refund to those customers that have previously contributed to the cost of each main extension itself that amount necessary to reduce their contribution to the currently calculated amount for each customer connected to that extension.

e. All customers directly connected to each main extension for a period of six (6) years after execution of agreement and or acceptance of the main shall contribute equally to the cost of construction of the water main extension itself. In addition, each customer must pay the approved "Tap-on-fee" applicable at the time of their application for the meter connection. The "Tap-on-fee" is not part of the refundable cost of the extension and may be changed during the refund period. After the six year refund period expires, any additional customers applying for service on each main extension shall be connected for the amount of the approved "Tap-on-fee" only.

6. Sub-Division Development Water Main Extension Contracts

The developer will pay the total cost of the water main extension. The District will pay the tap on charge to the supply main. The customer shall not be charged for any portion of the cost of the main extension.

V. DAMAGE TO WATER METERS

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2/1/2006*

- a. Water meters damaged by the customer from their attempts to thaw, alter, or change the meter readings in any way, shall be replaced by the District and the customer shall be charged, based on the actual cost of labor and materials, for the removal of the damaged meter and installation of the new meter.
- b. The customer shall be charged for damage to the remote read-out and cable when caused by customer's neglect, customer's animals, and attempt to alter the remote read-out. If a metal sheath cable has to be installed for cable protection, it shall be at the customer's expense. The charge shall be based on the actual cost of labor and materials.

W. PUBLIC OR PRIVATE FIRE HYDRANTS

1. Operation of Fire Hydrants

- a. The Crittenden-Livingston County Water District is organized primarily to supply potable water to all of the customers who request it and sign a tap-on request, and who live on roads served by the District. Flush type fire hydrants are provided at ends of lines and other places deemed necessary by engineers at the time of construction. These are the type which can be connected to standard fire truck connections and which are available for use of established fire departments. The District does not assume or guarantee any pressure or rate of flow of water and also prohibits direct connection of suction type hoses. Only flexible hoses may be used.
- b. Hydrants may be used by established fire departments by agreement with the District under conditions established by the Board of Commissioners for such services. Hydrants shall not be used for any other purpose without expressed permission of the District.

2. Penalty for Unauthorized Use

Anyone who shall operate or attempt to operate a fire hydrant without permission of the District may be prosecuted as provided by law.

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2/1/2006

3. Relocation of Hydrants

a. Where an existing fire hydrant interferes with a property owner's use or purpose of their property, the hydrant may be relocated by the District at the expense of the property owner making the request.

b. Where the grade of an existing road, street, or property is changed, at the request of the property owner, such that the existing hydrant will not be a proper elevation with respect to the ground, the hydrant will be lowered or raised at the expense of the property owner.

4. Obstruction of Hydrants

a. Nothing shall be erected or planted which shall interfere with the use of a hydrant. Sufficient clearance shall be maintained around the hydrant to permit easy connection of hoses and full circle operation of the hydrant using regular hydrant wrenches and hose spanners.

b. Shrubs, trees, flowers, or weeds shall not be permitted to grow around or close to a hydrant so as to prevent full view of a hydrant from the street or road.
