AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into by and between CITY OF LEITCHFIELD, by and through its UTILITIES COMMISSION, a municipal corporation, of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as "Seller", and GRAYSON COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, a municipal corporation, of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, hereinafter referred to as "Buyer."

WITNESSETH: THAT

WHEREAS, the Buyer and Seller have heretofore entered into an agreement whereby the rate for wholesale sale of water from the Seller to the Buyer is to be periodically established, and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to agree without the intervention of their respective engineers as provided in the said agreement for the sale of water,

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the previous agreements heretofore entered into by the parties, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. That the increase in said rates for the next, immediate contract period shall be increased in an amount equal to four (4%) percent of the now current contract rates, being the rate of inflation, and to be payable for the term of the said next contract period.

2. This agreement shall not be construed to alter, amend, or affect any of the terms or conditions of previous contracts between the parties.
