MULTI-USER RATE

The minimum bill to customers who serve two or more units, (apartment buildings, mobile home parks, trailer parks, or other multi-user premises), shall be the monthly water minimum (\$10.30) times the number of units available per customer. The monthly minimum shall entitle the customer to not less than 2,000 gallons of water, times the number of units available per month. The balance of the monthly usage shall be at the General Customer's rate set out above times the number of units available per customer.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. These rules and regulations are in addition to the rules of the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
2. Any resident of the Hardin County Water District No. 1 is eligible for water service at the regular prescribed rates, but there may be added upon Commission approval an amount of fifteen percent (15%) of the prescribed rates to the water bills of customers located outside of the Water District. (T)
3. The person (or firm) who applies for and receives water service to any property served by the waterworks system of the District shall be liable for the water charges prescribed for his (or its) particular type of connection.
4. All temporary water users of less than one month will be required to make payment in advance for the amount of water which the Waterworks General Manager estimates will be required.
5. No customer of said system (individual, corporate, or municipal) shall receive free water service or any water service without being charged the full rates prescribed for customers of the class in which customers fall.
6. That all rates and charges shall be billed on a monthly basis, but not necessarily on the basis of a calendar month, and each bill shall provide for a due date ten (10) days after the date of rendition of the bill. As to any bill or bills not paid within fifteen (15) days after the date of rendition of the bill there shall be added an additional charge of ten percent of the face amount of the bill, with the exception that each customer will be allowed one month per year that the delinquent charge will be waived.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 7. The District shall have the right immediately and at any time twenty (20) days after the rendition of the bill, and a five (5) days written notice, disconnect the water service of the delinquent user, and is required to disconnect such service if such bill together with the penalty is not paid within a period of sixty (60) days after its due date. If water service is disconnected for nonpayment, a \$10.00 reconnect charge will be paid by the user before service will be reconnected.
- 8. The District shall make a test of any meter upon written request of any customer if the request is not made more frequently than once each twelve (12) months. The customer shall be given the opportunity to be present at the request tests. If the meter in service is found to be more than an average error of two percent (2%) fast or slow, there will be (T) no expense to the customer. This service shall be done at the convenience of the District.
- 9. The District will only be obligated to provide a service connection at the prices prescribed only when a water main is located on a road or street fronting the property that is to be served.
- 10. The rates set out herein shall be charged from the date each respective user begins to receive water service from the waterworks system of the District. The first collection period for any user or users may be less than one month, such rates shall be pro-rated when usage is 2,000 gallons or less in the following manner:
  - 0 - 10 days = 1/3 the minimum charge (N) (R)
  - 11 - 20 days = 2/3 the minimum charge
  - over 20 days = full minimum charge

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 11. If at any time a customer feels that he is over metered, upon a written request to the Hardin County Water District, he may have the meter size changed; but if at a later date the customer requests his meter to be changed back to the larger size, he will be required to pay the difference in the connection charge of the different size services.
- 12. Hardin County Water District may require an equal cash deposit for the purpose of establishing or maintaining any customer's credit, such amount not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the average annual bill. This amount will not exceed the average bill of residential customers served by the District. Interest shall accrue on all deposits at the rate prescribed by law, beginning on the date of deposit. Interest accrued shall be credited to the customer's bill on an annual basis, except that if the customer's bill is delinquent on the anniversary of the deposit date. Service may be refused or discontinued for failure to pay the requested deposit. The deposit may be waived upon a customer's showing of satisfactory credit or payment history, and upon request, required deposits will be returned after 18 months if the customer has established a satisfactory payment record for that period. If a deposit has been waived or returned and the customer fails to maintain a satisfactory payment record, a deposit may then be required. The District may require a deposit in addition to the initial deposit if the customer's classification of service changes or if there is a substantial change in usage. Upon termination of service, the deposit, any principal amounts, and any interest earned and owing will be credited to the final bill with any remainder refunded to the customer.
