This contract, made this 22<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1993, by and between Jackson County Water Association, Inc., P.O. Box 232, Tyner, Kentucky, 40486, hereinafter referred to as "J.C.W.A.," and Rockcastle County Water Association, 507 Three Links Road, Kentucky 40447, hereinafter referred to as "R.C.W.A."

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WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the covenants and payments hereinafter stated, the parties agree as follows:   
 PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 5011,

 FOR THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

1. The term of this contract shall begin on the first day of regular monthly water service billing and shall terminate 24 months from that date with renewal to be by mutual agreement.

2. J.C.W.A. agrees to provide monthly billing services and to provide water line maintenance for water lines and customers located on the following roads or sections of roads:

- KY 1912, Rice Hill School Road, Robinson Road, Bud Clark Road,
- KY 2614, Baker Road, Blue Sexton Road, and KY 1004.

3. The duties and responsibilities of Jackson County Water Association pursuant to this contract shall include the following:

- a) Billing Services:
  - 1) Record and generate bills by mail per rate schedule.
  - 2) Maintain records for all customer accounts.
  - 3) Provide flow or volume usage data by either area or road, as required by R.C.W.A.

4) Add other general mailing and ~~not to be~~ <sup>PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION</sup> ~~effective~~ <sup>OF KENTUCKY</sup> to monthly billings, as required. <sup>EFFECTIVE</sup>

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- b) Water Line Maintenance Services: <sup>PURSUANT TO 807 KAR 5.011, SECTION 9 (1)</sup>
- 1) Install, remove, and maintain ~~meters, and~~ <sup>By meters, and</sup> investigate and repair breaks, upon request, when the regular contractor of R.C.W.A. is unable to perform these duties. <sup>FOR THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION</sup>

4. R.C.W.A. shall pay to J.C.W.A. as compensation for billing services as stated in numerical paragraph three (3. a) above, the cost to J.C.W.A. based on labor cost, postage, and equipment use, plus 15%. The parties agree that at the time this contract becomes effective, the cost to J.C.W.A. is \$ .57, for a total of \$ .65 (\$ .57 cost plus 15%) per meter billed for per month. The cost to J.C.W.A. may be reviewed on an annual basis and shall be increased if there is a demonstrable increase in said cost based on additional labor cost, postage, equipment cost, or similar expenses to J.C.W.A. Payments for services rendered under this contract will be made by the 31st day of the month following the billing. R.C.W.A. shall pay to J.C.W.A. as compensation for all duties and responsibilities in connection with the water line maintenance as stated in numerical paragraph three (3. b) above, the actual cost of labor and materials to J.C.W.A., plus an additional 15%.

5. This contract contains the entire understanding of the parties. It may not be changed orally but only by an agreement in

writing signed by the party against whom enforcement of any waiver, change, modification, extension, or discharge is sought.
