

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

RATES

Where a meter is installed on a fire hydrant or on a temporary service connection for construction purposes, the minimum payment for water shall be the monthly service charge for general water service, payable in advance based upon the size of the meter installed. If more than one fire hydrant or temporary service connection is used, the service charge is to apply to each such hydrant or temporary service connection so used.

(T) The Company may require an application to be signed and either the service charge paid in advance or, at the option of the Company, a meter deposit made, and the account handled in the same manner as any other metered account. The service charge will not entitle the Customer to any water and all water used shall be billed at the meter rate schedule. In addition to such charges the Customer shall pay all reasonable costs incurred in connection with the installation and removal of the meter.



RATES

There shall be added to the Customer's bill, as a separate item, an amount equal to the proportionate part of any license, occupation, franchise, or other similar fee or tax now or hereafter imposed upon the Company by local taxing authorities, whether imposed by ordinance, franchise or otherwise, and which fee or tax is based upon a percentage of the gross receipts, net receipts, or revenues from sales of water or services rendered by the Company to the Customer.

Where more than one such charge or tax is imposed, the total of such charges or taxes applicable to a Customer may be billed to the Customer as a single amount.

Charges or taxes herein referred to shall in all instances be billed to customers on the basis of Company rates effective at the time of billing, and on the basis of the tax rate effective at the time billing is made.

(I) When it has been necessary to discontinue water service to any premises because of a violation of the Company's Rules and Regulations on account of nonpayments of any bill for water service, a charge of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) will be made to cover the expense of turning on the water service.

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
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
