

21. ACCURACY REQUIREMENTS OF WATER METERS

- (a) General. All meters used for measuring the quantity of water delivered to a Customer shall be in good mechanical condition and shall be adequate in size and design for the type of service which they measure.
- (b) Repaired Meters. All meters removed from service for repairs or test in accordance with this regulation, shall be tested as specified herein prior to being placed in service.
- (c) Determination of Accuracy. Meters shall be tested at the minimum test flow and at least two test flows in the normal test flow limits, one of which shall be not less than 75% of the rated maximum capacity of the meter and the other shall be at approximately 25% of the rated maximum capacity. No new meter shall be placed in service if it registers less than 95% of the water passed through it at the minimum test flow or over registers or under registers more than 1 1/2% in the normal test flow limits. No repaired or reconditioned meter shall be placed in service if it registers less than 80% of the water passed through it at the minimum test flow or over registers or under registers more than 1 1/2% in the normal test flow limits.
- (d) As Found Tests. All meters tested in accordance with the rules for periodic, request or complaint tests, shall be tested in the condition as found in the Customer's service prior to any alteration or adjustment in order to determine the average meter error. This test shall consist of two rates of flow in the normal test flow range for that type of meter and the average meter error shall be the algebraic average of the errors of the two tests.

22. BILL ADJUSTMENT

- (a) Whenever a meter in service is found upon periodic request or complaint test to be more than two percent (2%) fast, additional tests shall be made at once to determine the average error of the meter. Said tests shall be made in accordance with the Commission's regulation applicable to the type of meter involved.


