3. Rates (Cont'd)

In addition to the foregoing rates a temporary construction surcharge of \$4.50 shall be added to each monthly bill for a period of five (5) years from the effective date hereof.

N In addition to the foregoing rates and temporary construction surcharge a second temporary construction surcharge of \$1.80 shall be added to each monthly bill for a period not to exceed five (5) years from the effective date hereof as set out in PSC Order No. 91-326. If the sum total surcharge proceeds and any accumulated interest earned thereon reaches \$155,000.00 before the 5 year period ends, assessment of the surcharge shall cease.

3A. SURCHARGE: A Water Loss Demonstration Project surcharge of \$0.94 per bill per month shall be imposed for a period not to exceed three (3) years from the 30th day of December, 1985.

3B. PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT APPLICABLE TO ALL RATE SCHEDULES:

(1) The rates authorized herein are based upon the wholesale cost of water to the utility pursuant to valid contracts or wholesale tariffs on file with the Commission. For the purposes of this purchased water adjustment clause, the wholesale rate shall be considered as the base rate for purchased water and any increase or decrease in the base rate shall be considered the changed rate. In the event there is a change in the base rate, the utility shall file with the Commission the following information:

(a) A copy of the wholesale supplier's tariff effecting a change in the base rate and a statement from the wholesale supplier evidencing the effective date of the changed rate;

(b) A detailed statement of water purchased under the base rate for a 12-month period ended within 90 days of the filing date and showing billing both under such base rate and under the changed rate;

(c) A detailed statement of water sold for the same 12-month period;

5. The principal place of business of the Association will be 800 Pleasant Hill Drive, Burgin, Kentucky, Monday through Friday from 8:30 A.M. to 1:00 P.M.

6. Water bills may be paid at 800 Pleasant Hill Drive, Burgin, Kentucky, 40310, or mailed to P.O. Box 303, Burgin, Kentucky, 40310.

7. SCOPE: This Schedule of Rules and Regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the Association, and applies to all service received from the Association whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application, or otherwise. A copy of this tariff, which includes the Association's Schedule of Rates and Charges shall be kept open to inspection at the office of the Association. The rules are promulgated under direction and authority granted pursuant to Chapter 5 of Kentucky Administrative Regulations which are hereby adopted and included the same as if herein written.

8. REVISIONS: These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed from time to time by either of the two (2) following methods:

(A) By order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission upon formal application by the Association, and after hearing as provided by Commission Regulations.

C. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep such pipes in a suitable state of repair.

D. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or valves, or permitting such tampering by others.

E. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separate water supply to premises which receive water from the Association.

F. Non-payment of bills.

G. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, with reference to the continuation of water service, water service shall be cut off without notice or shall be refused, provided the Association shall notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the discontinuance or refusal and the corrective action to be taken by the applicant or customer before service can be restored.

if, prior to discontinuance of service, there is delivered to the Association, or its employee empowered to discontinue service, a written certificate signed by a physician, a registered nurse, or a public health officer that, in the opinion of the certifier, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity at the affected premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until ten (10) days elapse from the time of the Association receipt of said certification, whichever occurs first.

17. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY CUSTOMER: Any customer having fulfilled their contract terms and desiring to discontinue the water service to his premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in writing at the business office of the Association at least three (3) days prior to the date on which the customer desires to discontinue service. If such notice in writing is not given, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered to his premises by the Association until said notice is received by the Association.

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18. RECONNECTION FEE: Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$45.00 will be made for

reconnection of water service; however, the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed to the Association on that meter have been paid regardless of any change of ownership of the premise served by the meter.

19. DEPOSIT: The Association reserves the right to require that a nominal amount be placed on deposit with the Association for the purpose of establishing or maintaining any customer's credit. The deposit will not exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the customer's estimated annual bill. Upon payment of deposit, the Association shall issue to the customer a certificate of deposit, showing the name of the customer, the location of the initial premises occupied by the customer, and the date and amount of the deposit. The Association will pay interest on the customer's deposit at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum, until the date of its refund to the customer.

20. ADJUSTMENT RELATIVE TO ERRONEOUS METER: If a meter is inaccurate in excess of +2%, whether upon periodic testing or upon requested testing, additional tests shall be made at once to determine the average error of the meter, and the adjustments shall be made in the customer's water bills as follows:

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
