RULES AND REGULATIONS

This schedule of Rules and Regulations governs the furnishing of water service by MARTIN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT #1 hereinafter referred to as the Utility and applies to all service received from the Utility. No employee or individual director of the Utility is permitted to make an exception to Rates, Rules or Regulations. All Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations. The Utility is further subject to all Rules and Regulations of the Commission even though not contained herein.

REVISIONS

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented or otherwise changed from time to time subject to approval of the Public Service Commission, and shall have the same force as the present Rules and Regulations.

SERVICE AREA

The Utility furnishes water service to INEZ AND WARFIELD AREA located at INEA AND WARFIELD in MARTIN county, Kentucky.

AVAILABILITY

Water service is available to any domestic, commercial, or industrial consumer within the Utility's area.

WATER FAILURE

The Utility is responsible for water failure only when in control of the Utility's employees. No consumer is paid damages for equipment unless such damages are specifically found to be caused by an act of negligence on the part of the Utility or its employees.

PROTECTION BY CONSUMER

Consumer shall protect the equipment of the Utility on his premises and shall not interfere with Utility's property or permit interference except by duly authorized representatives of the Utility.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

NOTICE OF TROUBLE

Consumer shall give immediate notice to the Utility of any irregularities or unsatisfactory service and of any defects known to consumer.

MAINTENANCE

The Utility may at any time deemed necessary, suspend sewer service to any consumer or consumers for the purpose of making repairs, changes or improvements upon any part of its system. The Utility shall give reasonable notice of such suspension of service to the consumer.

The Utility shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion of the service line installed by the Utility and the consumer shall be responsible for the maintenance of that portion thereof installed by the consumer.

EXTENSIONS OF SERVICE

Extension of service shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12.

RELOCATIONS

When necessary to move or relocate facilities, the cost will be paid by party or parties requesting such relocation.

BILLING, COLLECTION, PENALTIES

Bills for water service furnished by the water system will be mailed no later than the 30th day of each month and will be due and payable within 10 (ten) days (or by the 10th day of the following month). A 10 % late payment penalty charge will be applicable after the due date of any account.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

DEPOSITS

The Utility may require from any customer or applicant for service a cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill for such customer or applicant where bills are rendered monthly, or three-twelfths (3/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered bimonthly, or four-twelfths (4/12) of the estimated annual bill where bills are rendered quarterly. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum will be paid on deposits so required, accruing from the date of deposit.

DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY UTILITY

The Utility may refuse or discontinue service to an applicant or customer, after proper notice, for failure to comply with its rules and regulations or state and municipal rules and regulations, when a customer or applicant refuses or neglects to provide reasonable access to the premises, for discontinuance is for non-payment of bills, the customer shall be given at least forty-eight (48) hours written notice, separate from the original bill, and cut-off shall be effected not less than twenty (20) days after the mailing date of the original bill unless, prior to discontinuance, a residential customer presents to the utility a written certificate, signed by a physician, registered nurse, or public health officer, that such discontinuance will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity on the affected premises, in which case discontinuance may not be effected until the affected resident can make other living arrangements or until not less than ten (10) days elapse from the date of the Utility's notification. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, the service shall be cut off without notice or refused.

provided that the utility notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the discontinuance or refusal and the corrective action to be taken by the applicant or customer before service can be rendered.

SECTION 9 METER READINGS AND BILL ADJUSTMENT

Water meters shall be read monthly commencing on the 20th day of each calendar month or as soon thereafter as weather and other conditions and circumstances may reasonably permit, and such reading shall continue as expeditiously as possible until all of the meters have been read.

1/2 of Areas will be read on the 10th of each month
In the event, upon periodic inspection, a meter is found to be in error in excess of 2%, either fast or slow, than an adjustment shall be made under the provisions set out in 807 KAR 2:010 Section 9:(1),(2),(3) & (4).

Large leaks shall be adjusted by adding the previous 6 months bills and dividing by 6 to arrive at an average bill. This shall only be done once per year.

No adjustments will be made on dual-hook ups.

SECTION 10 DEPOSITS

A deposit shall be made with the District for water service by any applicant desiring service, except resident property owners, before being entitled to such service. The amount of such deposit shall be \$25.00. For temporary service (such as fairs, carnivals, etc.) a deposit of \$50.00 shall be required. Such deposit, less any unpaid charges, shall be refunded to such customer, his heirs or assigns, within 30 days after such customer notifies the District legally to disconnect or terminate service to such customer. This refund shall include interest at a rate of 6% annually.

SECTION 11 OWNERS PAY CONNECTION CHARGES; OCCUPANTS PAY RATES

Connection charges, where applicable, shall be the personal obligation of the owners of the respective properties. All water charges, other than connection charges, shall be the personal obligation, collectible by law, of the occupant of the lot, property or building receiving the benefits of such use and service so long as the same continues, and the satisfaction of the liability by any party shall be a discharge of the liability for which the payment is made. An easement must be signed before connection is made.

be revised from time to time, and whenever required shall be increased, so as to produce income and revenues from the waterworks system adequate to comply with such covenants and agreements as may be made by the District in connection with the Revenue Bond Issue financing referred to herein.

SECTION 13 BILLING; COLLECTION; PENALTIES; DISCONNECTION OF WATER SERVICE; RECONNECTION

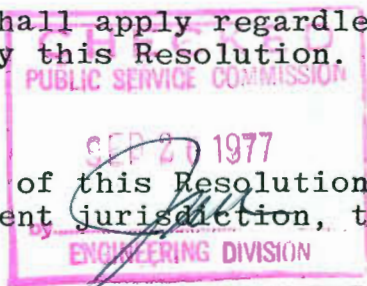
The rates or charges aforesaid shall be billed monthly on or about the first of each month, and all bills for such service shall be considered due and payable twenty days after rendition. If a bill is not paid as aforesaid within such twenty-day period, there shall be imposed a penalty on each bill not so paid, in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the charges (other than sales tax) shown on the face amount of said bill not so paid. Also, if a bill is not paid within said twenty-day period after said due date, the charges shown on such bill shall be deemed delinquent, and the Superintendent of the waterworks system, after furnishing 48 hours written notice to the delinquent water user, shall thereupon, if such delinquency continues, turn off the water of such user according to the current practices existing at the time of the turn-off for water delinquents and may further enjoin use of the water facilities of the District by said customer until payment in full is made. If the deadline date falls on a Sunday or legal holiday, such deadline shall not expire until the next secular day thereafter. If such water service is cut off by the District, reconnection of such service shall not be made until the owner or user pays all charges and penalties owed plus the amount of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) as a reconnection charge. If water service is discontinued at the request of the water customer at a time when such customer is not delinquent in the payment of any charges, then reconnection of such water service within 12 months from the time of the original connection shall not be made until a customer pays a reconnection charge of Five Dollars (\$5.00).

SECTION 14 DEPOSIT IS NO EXCUSE FOR DELINQUENCY

The foregoing provisions are intended to and shall apply regardless of the availability of any initial deposit required by this Resolution.

SECTION 15 SEVERABILITY

If any clause, provision, paragraph or section of this Resolution be ruled void or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, the

Whenever the minimum monthly charge is in excess of the total metered charge, the minimum shall apply. Whenever the total metered charge is in excess of the prescribed minimum monthly charge, the metered charge shall apply.

Section 1 of said Rate Resolution prescribes certain connection charges which have been amended by Section 2 of Amended Rate Resolution, a copy of which is attached hereto, as follows:

Section 2. REVISED WATER CONNECTION CHARGES.

That the schedule of water connection charges shall continue to be exacted for each connection with the waterworks system of the District, based on whether the application for water service was filed (a) prior to the time when said waterworks system was completed to the point of water service being available by an applicant who actually connects when service is available, or (b) subsequent to the time when said waterworks system was completed to the point of water service being so available, and such connection charges shall continue to be based on the respective sizes of meter connections as hereinafter provided.

A. For all customers for all size connections who have signed written applications for a water connection and have tendered to the District a water connection charge of \$25.00, agreeing to connect to the District waterworks system as soon as same was completed to the point of service being available, as evidenced by a Certification of the Engineers, and who actually connect to said waterworks system as soon as such water service becomes so available, the total connection charge shall be \$25.00.

B. For those customers who applied (or who hereinafter apply) for a water connection subsequent to the time when said waterworks system was completed to the point of service being so available, and for those customers, if any, who applied prior to said time of completion and availability and either failed to pay the \$25.00 connection charge or who failed to connect to said system as soon as issued by Authority of an Order of the Public Service Commission of Ky in Case #4982 Dntc 2 June 1970
