RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations govern the furnishing of water service by McKinney Water District and are in addition to the Rules of the Kentucky Service Commission as of September 1, 1987. These Rules and Regulations are to be in effect so long as they are not in conflict with the Kentucky Public Service Commission's Rules and Regulations.

1. Scope

This Schedule of Rules and Regulations is a part of all contracts for receiving water service from the District, and applies to all service received from the District whether the service is based upon contract, agreement, signed application, or otherwise. A copy of this schedule, together with a copy of the District's Schedule of Rates and Charges shall be kept open to inspection at the office of District. The rules are promulgated under direction and authority granted pursuant to Chapter 5 of Kentucky Administrative Regulations (807 KAR 5). The aforesaid rules and regulations are hereby adopted and included the same as if herein written.

2. Revisions

These Rules and Regulations may be revised, amended, supplemented, or otherwise changed from to time by either of the two (2) following methods:

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- A. By order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission upon formal application by the District, and after hearing as provided by Commission Regulation set forth in 807 KAR 5:011.
- B. By Issuing and filing on at least twenty (20) days notice to the Kentucky Public Service Commission and the public all proposed changes in the Rules and Regulations, as provided by Commission Regulations set forth in KAR 5:011.

3. Conflict

In case of conflict between any provisions of any rate schedule and the schedule of rules and regulations, the rate schedule shall apply. Also, should the rules contains herein conflict with rules in effect under 807 KAR 5, the provisions of 807 KAR 5 shall take precedence over those contained herein.

4. Application for Service.

Each prospective customer desiring water service is required to sign the District's Standard Water Service Contract before service is supplied by the District. No service will be installed unless there is a main distribution line existing along the road from which service is requested. If service is desired on the same side of the road as the main, the meter shall be installed within five feet of the water main. If service is desired on the opposite side of the road from the water main, the service line will be run under the road and the meter installed on private property adjacent to the highway right of way. If the distance from the main to either side of the road is greater than 50 feet, the customer will be required to pay

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the cost of installing the pipe for the additional footage. A contribution in aid of construction as provided in the Schedules of Rates and Charges must be paid on all new connections to the existing water lines. Applications for service connection installation will not be processed if the applicant is indebted to the District on a past due account, bad debt, or in any other fashion whatsoever. Extensions to the utility's main shall be in accordance with 807 KAR 5: 066, Section 12 (12).

5. Standard Service.

Each applicant for service shall receive by the order of Kentucky Public Service Commission a 5/8" x 3/4" meter.

6. Non - Standard Service

Each prospective customer requiring a non standard service (i.e., other than a 5/8 " x 3/4" meter) shall present to the District sufficient justification for same. All cost above standard will be the responsibility of the customer.

7. Point of Delivery.

The Point of delivery is the point where the meter or vault is located on the customer's premises. All water lines, plumbing, and equipment beyond the meter shall be installed and maintained by the customer. The District reserves the right to determine the location of point of delivery with full regard to the wishes of the prospective customer.

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8. Customer's Service Line.

All service lines beyond the metering point should be installed of material consisting of copper, galvanized, PVC or PE pipe with rating not less than 180 psi. The size of service line beyond the point of delivery should not be less than 3/4". ~~The District will not set a meter on the customer's service line at a point that does not deliver 30 psig at the meter.~~

Should an applicant for service desire a higher pressure due to his location or need, he may make provision for an individual pressure booster system. The manner of connection, location cross-connection protection and type is subject to approval by the District. The District reserves the right to require discontinuance and disconnection should the private booster system have a detrimental effect on District's system.

9. Ownership of Mains, Services & Appurtenances.

All mains, fire hydrants, valves, crossings, tanks, pumps, and other appurtenances are and shall remain the property of the District, whether installed by the District or the customer.

All service lines from main to meter with appurtenances shall be and remain the property of District, whether installed by the District or the customer.

The customer shall install, own and maintain his service line from meter and/or point of delivery as defined herein.

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10. Discontinuance of Service by District.

Water service may be discontinued by the District for any violation of any rule, regulation, or condition, and especially for any of the following reasons.

- A. Misrepresentation in the application or contract as to the property or fixtures to be supplied or additional use to be made of water.
- B. Resale of water.
- C. Waste or misuse of water due to improper or imperfect service pipes and/or failure to keep such pipes in a suitable state of repair.
- D. Tampering with meter, meter seal, service, or valves, or permitting such tampering by others.
- E. Connection, cross-connection, or permitting the same, of any separate water supply to premises which receive water from the District.
- F. Non-payment of bills.
- G. When a dangerous condition is found to exist on the customer's or applicant's premises, with reference to the continuation of water service, water service shall be cut off without notice or shall be refused, provided the District shall notify the customer or applicant immediately of the reasons for the discontinuance or refusal and the corrective action to be taken by the applicant or customer before service can be restored.

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11. Billing.

Bills and notices relating to the conduct of the business of the District will be mailed to the customer at the address listed on the "User's Agreement" unless a change of address has been filed in writing with the District; and the District shall not otherwise be responsible for delivery of any bill or notice nor will the customer be excused from payment of any bill or any performance required in said notice.

Bills for water service are due and payable at the office of the District, or mailable to the address of the District. Bills will be rendered monthly and shall be paid within fifteen(15) days from date of bill. Bills will be dated and mailed on or about the thirty (30) of each month.

A bill not paid on or before the fifteen (15) of the month shall be deemed delinquent. A ten(10) % late payment penalty charge will be applicable after the due date of any account. Should bills not be paid as above, the District may discontinue service after a written notice of intent to do so with customer's turn off date being not before twenty-seven (27) days after the mailing date of the original bill. However, if, prior to discontinuance of service, there is delivered to the District's office, a written certificate signed by a physician, a registered nurse, or a public health officer that, in the opinion of the certifier, discontinuance of service will aggravate an existing illness or infirmity of the affected premises, service shall not be discontinued until the affected resident

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notice is not given, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered to his premises by the District until said notice is received by the District.

13. Reconnection Fee

Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$20.00 will be made for reconnection of water services, but the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed by the customer to the District have been paid.

14. Deposit

The District reserves the right to require that a nominal amount be placed on deposit with the District for the purpose of establishing or maintaining all customers' credit. The deposit shall be either \$30.00 or two-twelfths (2/12) of the customer's estimated annual bill. Upon payment of deposit, the District shall issue to the customer a certificate of deposit, showing the name of the customer, the location of the initial premises occupied by the customer, and the date and the amount of the deposit. Interest will be paid on all sums held on deposit according to law. Interest on deposits will be refunded annually as set out in 807 KAR 5:006, Section 7.

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can make other living arrangements or until ten (10) days elapse from the time of the District receipt of said certification, whichever occurs first. Bills paid on or before the final date shall be payable at the net rates, but thereafter the gross rates shall apply as provided in the Schedule of Rates and Charges. Should the final date for payment of the bill at the net rates fall on a Sunday or holiday, the business day following the final date will be held as a day of grace for delivery of payment.

12. Discontinuance of Service by Customer.

Any customer having fulfilled their contract terms and desiring to discontinue the water service to his premises for any reason must give notice of discontinuance in writing at the business office of the District at least three (3) days prior to the date on which the customer desires to discontinue service. If such notice in writing is not given, a customer shall remain liable for all water used and service rendered to his premises by the District until said notice is received by the District.

13. Reconnection Fee.

Where the water supply to the customer has been discontinued for non-payment of delinquent bills, a charge of \$ 20.00 will be made for reconnection of water services, but the reconnection will not be made until all delinquent bills and other charges, if any, owed by the customer to the District have been paid.

14. Depoist.

The District reserves the right to require that a nominal amount be placed on depoist with the District for the purpose of establishing or maintaining all customer's credit. The depoist of \$ 30.00 or two-twelfths (2/12) of the customer's estimated annual bill. Upon payment of depoist, the District shall issue to the customer a certificate of depoist, showing the name of the customer, the location of the initial premises occupied by the customer, and the date and the amount of the depoist. Interest will be paid on all sums held on depoist at the rate of 6 percent annually. The interest will be applied as a credit to the customer's bill or will be paid to the customer on an annual basis. If the deposit is refunded or credited to the customer's bill prior to the depoist anniversary date, interest will be paid or credited to the customer's bill on a pro-rated basis. If interest is not credited to the customer's bill or paid to the customer annually, interest will be computed by a method which will result in an amount no less than that obtained by using a middle course method between simple and compound interest in compliance with Commission Order dated October 31, 1989 in Case No. 89-057. Interest on depoists computed in this manner will accrue until credited to the customer's bill or paid to the customer.

15. Adjustment Relative to Erroneous Meter.

If a meter is inaccurate in excess of 2% where annual testing or upon requested testing, the average error of the meter and the adjustments shall be made in the customer's water bills as follows:

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- A. If the result of such tests shows an average error greater than 2% fast the customer's bill for the period during which the meter error is know to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. If the period during which the meter error existed cannot be determined, then the customer's bill shall be recomputed for one-half (½) of the elapsed time since the last periodic test, but in no event to exceed 12 months. If however , the time for a periodic test has overrun to the extent that ½ of the time elapsed since the last periodic test exceeds 12 months, the refund shall be for the 12 months specified above, plus those months exceeding the periodic test period. The Kentucky Public Service Commission may not require a refund for the overrun period if failure to make the periodic test was due to causes beyond the control of the District.
- B. If the result of such tests shows an average error greater than 2% slow, the customer's bill for the period during which the meter error is known, to have existed, shall be recomputed and the account adjusted on the basis of the test. If the period during which the meter error existed cannot be determined, then the customer's bill shall be recomputed for one-half(½) of the elapsed time since the last test, but in no event to exceed 12 months.
- C. If the result of such tests necessitates making a refund or back billing a customer, the customer shall be notified in writing of the percentage of error, fast or slow, the date(s) of testing, and the amount of charge

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or credit to be shown on the next bill of the customer.

16. Meters.

All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the the District, and the District reserves the right to approve the size and type of meter used. It shall be the policy of the District to test each water meter pursuant to Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066 Section 16. In addition, upon written request of any customer, the meter servicing such customer shall be tested by the District, pursuant to Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5: 006, Section 20.

17. Failure of Water Meter.

Where a meter is found to be in error, the customer's bill will be adjusted in accordance with Section 14 herein per Kentucky Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5: 006, Section 9. Where a meter has ceased to register, the District will estimate the monthly bill of the customer for the month that the meter is replaced. The estimated bill will be based upon the previous six month's usage.

18. Right of Access.

The customer must agree to permit the District to lay, maintain, repair, or remove its water lines that are located on the customer's property with the right of ingress-and-egress over customer's property. The District's duly authorized representative and/or other duly authorized em-

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ployee of the State Health Department bearing proper credentials and identification shall be permitted to enter upon all properties for the purpose of inspection, observation, measurement, sampling and testing, in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and Regulations.

19. Interruption of Service.

The District will use reasonable diligence in supplying water service, but shall not be liable for loss, injury, or damage to persons or property. resulting from interruptions in service, excessive or inadequate water pressure. The District does hereby explicitly state that its system is one for rural domestic consumption and that its allowance of connections to its system for fire protection whether by design or implication is only for such benefit as a customer may be able to derive from such connection.

The District's system is not designed nor intended for use for fire protection in any manner whatsoever. Any customer using same for fire protection does so at their own full and sole responsibility.

The District shall in no event be held responsible for any claim made against it by reason of breaking of any mains or service pipes or by reason of any other interruption of the supply of water caused by the failure of machinery or stoppage for necessary repairs. No person shall be entitled to damages nor for any portion of a payment refunded for any interruption of service which in the opinion of the District may be deemed necessary.

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The District shall make all reasonable efforts to eliminate interruption of service and when such interruption occur will endeavor to re-store service with the shortest possible delay. When the service is interrupted all customers affected by such interruption will be notified in advance whenever it is possible to do so.

20. Boilers and /or Pressure Vessels.

Customers having boilers and/or pressure vessels receiving a supply of water from the District must have a check valve on the water supply line and a vacuum valve on the stream line to prevent collapse in case the water supply from the District is discontinued or interrupted for any reason, with or without notice. It is the responsibility of the customer to make provisions for protection of his equipment in case of interrupted or intermittant service.

21. Backflow Preventors.

Special services and fire connections shall have backflow preventors of a type approved by the District, installed at the cost of the customer or applicant for service.

22. Cross-Connection.

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nection of the District's system with any other source is hereby prohibited.

23. Relocation of Water Facility.

The District may, at the request of customer, relocate or change existing District - owned equipment. Customer will reimburse District for such changes at actual cost including appropriate overhead such as legal, administrative, engineering.

24. Damage to District's Water System.

No person shall maliciously, willfully, or negligently break, damage, destroy, uncover, deface, or tamper with any structure appurtenance, or equipment which is a part of the District's water works. Any person violating this provision shall be subject to immediate arrest and / or discontinuing of water service and shall pay the cost of repairing or replacing the pipe or appurtenance.

Any person, firm or organization involved in work around or near District's distribution mains or appurtenances may request the District to indicate location of same. However, indication by District of same does not relieve such person of complete responsibility and liability for any and all damages, liability and loss resulting from any act of such person or his assigns and / or agent.

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25. Additional Load.

The service connection supplied by the District for each customer has a definite capacity, and no addition to the equipment or load connected thereto will be allowed except by consent of the District. Failure to give notice of additions or changes in load, and to obtain the District's consent for same, shall render the customer liable for any damage to any of District's lines or equipment caused by the additional or changed installation.

26. Notice of Trouble.

The customer shall notify the District immediately should the service be unsatisfactory for any reason, or should there be any defects, trouble or accidents affecting the supply of water.

27. Water Main Extensions.

Any person desiring an extension to District system shall make a request in writing, in a form approved by the District, for such extension. Any requested extensions may be provided, under one of the following options:

OPTION I - District shall construct water main extensions under the authority and the procedure stipulated in Public Service Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12; A copy is attached hereto as Appendix

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I any extension made under this option shall be subject to refund as outlined in said regulation.

OPTION II - Applicant may construct and donate to District, the extension as a contribution in aid of construction, meeting all District's specifications and approval. District reserves right to stipulate applicable engineering, legal and administrative factors. Applicant shall pay all cost of District as a contribution in aid of construction. Any extension made under thos option shall not be eligible for refund.

The applicant or group of applicants shall have the right to elect the option by which said extensions shall be made. In either case applicant must execute a contract and agreement for line extension of form approved by District.

Extendor applicant is hereby notified that regradless of option selected, all other rules, rates and charges of fees applicable to size and type of service requested shall be paid in addition to cost of extension.

The above mentioned means of acquiring service shall be executed as long as allotted amount of water from supplier is within the suppliers contract and the District. If water useage is more then contract states supplier has the authority to curtail the amount the District receives.

28. Fire Hydrants.

McKinney Water District is not classified under fire control. The purpose of any hydrant within the system is for flushing lines. The District will continue to furnish water for fire protection to all fire departments in it's area of distribution. The District will not be responsible for any given pounds of pressure at the fire hydrants in it's system at any given time. The use of hydrants will be strictly limited to authorized periodic drill purposes and emergency (i.e., fire fighting) use only. The fire protection district, or any volunteer fire department will be responsible for the up keep of fire hydrants in their area. Also, they are responsible for the replacement of fire hydrants in the District if any are torn out or damaged in any way.

29. Complaints.

Complaints may be made by a customer in writing or at the office during business hours. Decisions made concerning such complaints will only be made by the Board of Commissioners. Decisions of the District's Commissioners may be brought before the Public Service Commission in accordance with 807 KAR 5: 006, Section 8.

30. Sale of Water.

Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the customer's household or business, subject to special service

agreements. The customer shall not sell, donate, give or allow use of such water to any authorized or unauthouized party.

31. Purchased Water Adjustment Clause.

The District will implement upon PSC approval a purchased water adjustment designed to recover the increased costs of water purchased due to the fact that the District is not financially able to absorb the increased costs from its supplier. A copy is attached hereto as Appendix II.

32. Special Charges.

Special charges may be assessed to the customer for returned checks, meter rereads, and meter tests at the specified charges shown below:

- A. A charge of \$5.00 will be made for each check returned to the District by the bank.
- B. A charge of \$10.00 will be made to reread a meter at the customers request unless such reread reveals that the initial reading was erroneous. No charge shall be made if the initial reading was erroneous.
- C. A charge of \$ 25.00 will be made for a meter test when such test is made at the customer's request unless the meter is found to be faulty. No charge shall be made for a faulty meter, but appropriate adjustments shall be made in accordance with Section 15 of these Rules and Regulations.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

SCHEDULE OF SPECIAL SERVICE CHARGES

The following charges for special services shall be made:

1. Service Reconnection Charge. A charge of \$20.00 shall be made for all service reconnections made, except that there shall be no connection charges made for service on the original installation of facilities.
2. Meter Reading Recheck Charge. A charge of \$10.00 shall be made for a trip to recheck a meter reading when the customer requests the meter to be rechecked for a correct reading and the meter was not misread.
3. Meter Test. Upon request and payment of \$25.00 a customer may have his meter tested provided request by the customer is not more than once each twelve months. If such test shows the meter to be more than two per cent fast, a refund of the \$25.00 charge shall be made and the bill adjusted accordingly. If the periodic testing requirement of 807 KAR 5:066 (17) has not been met for the meter tested, a charge will be made for the test regardless of test result.
4. PSC Meter Test Complaint. Any customer of the District may request a meter test by written application to the Kentucky Public Service Commission.
5. Contribution in Aid of Construction. The established contribution fee is based on the size of the installed metering equipment as noted below.

THIS WATER USER CONTRACT, issued for _____,

will be known and referred to as CUSTOMER, and the McKinney Water District
of McKinney, Ky., 40448, will be known and referred to as WATER DISTRICT:

W I T N E S S E T H:

BY SIGNING THIS CONTRACT THE CUSTOMER DOES HEREBY AGREE TO ALL OF THE
FOLLOWING:

The CUSTOMER agrees to purchase water from the WATER DISTRICT and to pay
all initial installation and connection fees, together with all standard
monthly water charges which may be fixed by the Board of Commissioners
of the McKinney Water District, which have been approved by the Public
Service Commission of Frankfort, Ky. The CUSTOMER agrees to pay each
consecutive monthly water bill in full, at all appropriate rates, for
water service, when due. The CUSTOMER agrees he/she knows all bills
are due by the 15th of each month, after which a 10% penalty will be
added on, and disconnection of water meter for any unpaid balance after
27 days of mailing the original bill.

The CUSTOMER agrees to comply with, and be bound by, the provisions
of the policy and/or amendments of the WATER DISTRICT, together with
all rules and regulations, which from time to time, may be changed
or added to by the WATER DISTRICT.

The CUSTOMER agrees to permit the WATER DISTRICT to lay, maintain, re-
pair, remove, and disconnect a service line and meter, and read meter
at a point on CUSTOMER'S property to be designated by the WATER DISTRICT
for each meter, with the right to enter and leave for these purposes
over CUSTOMER'S property.

The CUSTOMER will install and maintain a service line at his/her own
expense, which service line will begin at the water meter and extend
to the dwelling. The CUSTOMER assumes responsibility for any damage
to metering equipment in making such connection to the meter.
