RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following Rules and Regulations are subject to change by the Commission at any time.

These Rules and Regulations are intended to supplement the Bond Resolution, the Rate Resolution, and the By-Laws.

1. Meters will be read monthly between the 1st and 3rd of each month.
2. Bills will be dated and mailed on the first of each month. Said bills will state that they are to be paid by the 20th of the month or service will be discontinued.
3. All meters will be located on district mains and in the absence of special permission on the property to be served.
4. Complaints may be made to the operator of the system and may be appealed to the District Commission within 10 days.
5. The principal place of business of the District will be 205½ Main Street, Williamsburg, Kentucky.
6. Water bills may be paid at 205½ Main Street, Williamsburg, Kentucky.
