	5	If any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or other injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customer, member of his household, his agent or employee, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer. Water furnished by the District may be used for domestic consumption by the customer, member of his household, and employees only. The customer shall not sell the water to any other person. All customers shall grant or convey, or shall be caused to be granted or conveyed, to the District a perpetual easement and right-of-way across any property owned or controlled by the customer wherever said easement or right-of-way is necessary for the District water facilities and lines so as to be able to furnish service to the customer.
