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RULES AND REGULATIONS

- L. The Commission shall, upon written request of the owner of the real property, direct all bills to the owner of the real property served or to the occupant of the premises. The District shall not be required to furnish water service to any real property served until all delinquent bills, penalties and unpaid charges are paid in full.
- M. The Commission may require from any customer or applicant for service a minimum cash deposit or other guaranty to secure payment of bills of an amount not to exceed two-twelfths (2/12) of the estimated annual bill of such customer or applicant.
- N. All meters shall be installed, renewed, and maintained at the expense of the District and the District reserves the right to determine the size and type of meter used.
- 0. Upon written request of any customer, the meter serving said customer shall be tested by the District. Such test will be made without charge to the customer if the meter has not been tested within twelve (12) months preceding the requested test; otherwise, a charge of \$4.00 will be made and then only if the test indicates meter accuracy within the limits of two percent (2%). If a meter is inaccurate in excess of two percent (2%), adjustments shall be made for such periods as set forth pursuant to the current rules and regulations adopted by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky.

T. The premises receiving a supply of water and all service CHECKED lines, meters and fixtures, including any fixtures within the Service Commission said premises, shall at all reasonable hours be subject to inspection by the District.

TARIFFE

- U. Piping on the premises of a customer must be so installed that connections are conveniently located with respect to the District lines and mains. The customer shall provide a place for metering which is unobstructed and accessible at all times.
- V. The customer's service line shall be installed and maintained by the customer at his own expense in a safe and efficient manner and in accordance with the District rules and regulations and with the regulations of the Department of Health.

If any loss or damage to the property of the District or any accident or other injury to persons or property is caused by or results from the negligence or wrongful action of the customer, member of his household, his agent or employee, the cost of the necessary repairs or replacements shall be paid by the customer to the District and any liability otherwise resulting shall be that of the customer.
