Notification of Ownership Change

Dear Mr. Dorman:

On August 19, 2003, American Cellular Corporation (“American Cellular”) restructured its debt and changed its equity ownership. American Cellular indirectly owns 100% of and controls the day-to-day operations of ACC Kentucky License LLC (“ACC Kentucky”), a commercial mobile radio service provider in Kentucky. Prior to the restructuring, Dobson Communications Corporation (“DCC”) indirectly owned 50% of American Cellular. As a result of the restructuring, American Cellular has become a wholly-owned, indirect subsidiary of DCC. DCC exercised *de facto* control of ACC Kentucky prior to the restructuring and continues to exercise *de facto* control. The Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) regards this change in ownership as a *pro forma* transfer of control, and it will have no effect on operations or customers.
