SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF AT&T CORP.

AT&T Services, Inc. on behalf of its affiliate AT&T Corp. ("AT&T"), applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended ("the Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.71, to discontinue RingCentral Office@Hand from AT&T ("Office@Hand"), an interconnected VoIP service.

As required by Section 63.71(a) and (b) of the Commission's rules, AT&T provides the following information:

Name and Address of Carrier:

AT&T Corp. 208 S. Akard Street, 16th Floor Dallas, TX 75202

Date of Planned Service Discontinuance:

AT&T plans to transition existing customers from Office@Hand service over a twelve-month period beginning when this application is approved (as early as February 2018) and ending January 31, 2019 ("Transition Period").

Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

AT&T will discontinue this service throughout the United States.

Brief Description of Type of Service Affected:

RingCentral Office@Hand from AT&T is a hosted interconnected VoIP service targeted to small and medium-size businesses. AT&T uses a platform owned and managed by RingCentral, Inc. ("RingCentral") to provide Office@Hand service. On December 21, 2017, AT&T and RingCentral entered into an agreement, pursuant to which, upon completion of the Transition Period, AT&T will no longer provide Office@Hand service in the United States, and all existing Office@Hand customers will be transitioned to RingCentral.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by this service discontinuance because AT&T's existing customers will obtain the same service and features from RingCentral, and furthermore, there are many providers of interconnected VoIP services serving the small and medium business market, including other services offered by AT&T.

Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers:

AT&T notified its customers of its intention to discontinue this service and transition their service by letter sent via first class U.S. Mail on January 16, 2018.¹ Copies of this Application are being sent, first class U.S. Mail, to the public utilities commissions and governors of the affected states and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.

Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

AT&T is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

On December 21, 2017, AT&T entered into an agreement with RingCentral to transition all RingCentral Office@Hand from AT&T ("Office@Hand") customers to RingCentral's Office service over a twelvementh period ending January 31, 2019.

Federal Communications Commission Notification Requirements

Because Office@Hand service is an Interconnected VoIP service, the Federal Communications Commission requires AT&T to notify all RingCentral Office@Hand customers of its intention to transition support of this service to Ring Central. Therefore, this letter serves as your formal notification of AT&T's intent to transition the RingCentral Office@Hand support to Ring Central following the standard Federal Communications Commission review. We expect the Federal Communications Commission to approve the transition as early as February 2018, at which time we will begin transitioning support to RingCentral.

The Federal Communications Commission will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service (or reduction or impairment) unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance (or reduction or impairment) upon you or your company, including any inability to acquire reasonable substitute service.
