APPLICATION OF NATIONNET COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION

1. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.020 and the rules and regulations of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, ("NationNet Communications Corporation" or "Applicant") respectfully seeks a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, local exchange services through the use of its own facilities and special access 1 local exchange services in the areas served by BellSouth Telecommunications , Inc. ("Bell South") as defined by KRS 278.020.

¹ NationNet Communications Corporation uses the term "special access" primarily to refer to providing customer access to interexchange carriers and interexchange carriers access to NationNet Communications Corporation's customers.

Approval of this Application will promote the public interest by increasing the level of competition in the provision of telecommunications services in Kentucky. Therefore, NationNet Communications Corporation respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide the various telecommunications services described above. In support thereof, NationNet Communications Corporation provides the following information:

- A. NationNet Communications Corporation is a privately held corporation incorporated under the laws of Delaware. A corporate organizational chart, in addition to a copy of NationNet Communications Corporation's Incorporation and authorization to do business in the State of Kentucky, is attached hereto.
- 3. Name, street address, telephone number and fax number (if any) of the responsible contact person for customer complaints and regulatory issues.

- A. NationNet Communications Corporation will seek to provide operator assisted services to traffic

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aggregators but in doing so it will comply with the Commission's mandates in Administrative Case No. 330.

6. <u>Managerial Qualifications</u>

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NationNet Communications Corporation has the managerial qualifications to provide the telecommunications services for which authority is requested in this Application. NationNet Communications Corporation's management team has an extensive telecommunications experience and expertise. NationNet Communications Corporation's management personnel have held executive positions with a number of companies prior to joining NationNet Communications Corporation, which qualifies them to implement and provide the local exchange and interexchange services for which authority is requested. Resumes for the management team are included in this application.

7. Financial Qualifications

NationNet Communications Corporation is financially qualified to provide the telecommunications services for which authority is being requested in Kentucky. In particular, NationNet Communications Corporation has access to the financing and capital necessary to conduct its telecommunications operations as specified in this application. This capital will be available to meet the current and future capital needs of NationNet Communications Corporation's Kentucky operations. In support of NationNet Communications Corporation's application, attached hereto is a copy of NationNet Communications Corporation's most recent financial statements, along with a three-year projected forecast. This is offered to demonstrate NationNet Communications Corporation's financial ability to provide the proposed services.

8. <u>Technical Qualifications</u>

NationNet Communications Corporation has the technical qualifications to provide the telecommunications services for which authority is requested in Kentucky. Applicant will not require customers to purchase Customer Premises Equipment which cannot be used with the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier's systems. NationNet Communications Corporation will provide high quality (digital wherever possible) service, which will be available on a full time basis, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

NationNet Communications Corporation will employ certified engineering support from both utility companies and engineering firms to produce detailed installation plans. It will then hire certified contractors to install the equipment (electrical contractors to perform work in the electrical space and telecommunications contractors to perform work in the communications space).

9. <u>Proposed Services</u>

NationNet Communications Corporation intends to offer local exchange services, switched and special access services.

10. Local Exchange Services

With respect to its local exchange offerings, NationNet Communications Corporation intends to provide all forms of intrastate telecommunications services including: (1) basic exchange services; (2) custom and CLASS features; (3) ancillary services (911, E911), directory listings, directory assistance, etc.); and (4) special access services.

11. Current Certification

NationNet Communications Corporation is currently seeking authority to provide local telecommunications services in Tennessee, Florida, Arkansas, Alabama, Texas, Indiana, Nevada and

Florida. The Applicant proposes to offer its services throughout the state of Kentucky, in areas that are currently being served by BellSouth, which are designated open to competition.

12. Implementation Timeframe

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After receiving Commission approval from the Public Service Commission of Kentucky, NationNet Communications Corporation intends to enter into interconnection agreements with BellSouth . After entering into these interconnection agreements, NationNet Communications Corporation intends to commence providing its telecommunications services in Kentucky as expeditiously as possible.

13. Repair and Maintenance

NationNet Communications Corporation understands the importance of effective customer service for local service customers. NationNet Communications Corporation has made arrangements for its customers to call the company at its toll free customer service number, 1-888-420-7781. In addition, customers may contact the company in writing at the headquarters address. The toll free number will be printed on the customer's monthly billing statements. The Kentucky contact person for this is Amy Marcella and she can be reached at 731-660-6596.

14. Miscellaneous

A sworn pre-filed testimony from Ralph Monroe is provided in this application.

15. Complaints

NationNet Communications Corporation has not had any formal complaints filed against it.

16. Public Interest

The granting of NationNet Communications Corporation's application for local exchange and interexchange authority is in the public interest and will serve the public convenience and necessity. In enacting the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, the United States Congress determined that it is in the public interest to promote competition in the provision of telecommunications services, including local exchange services. Experience with competition in other telecommunications markets, such as long distance, competitive access, and customer premise equipment, demonstrates the benefits that competition can bring to consumers. Consumers are enjoying increased services, lower prices, higher quality and greater reliability. This is true not only with respect to the service offerings of the new entrants, but also as a result of the response of incumbent monopoly providers to the introduction of competition.

17. <u>Conclusion</u>

The telecommunications industry is growing and changing at an impressive pace. The entry of NationNet Communications Corporation into the local exchange and interexchange market will promote the public interest by enhancing competition in the provision of telecommunications services within Kentucky.
