

Please find attached revised tariff pages of Section A13 of the General Subscriber Services Tariff, which introduces a new pricing structure for 9-1-1 PinPoint service associated with Primary Rate ISDN (PRI) service. Existing PRI subscribers may retain the per 1,000 station records pricing structure as long as they continue the same service at their current location.

This new pricing structure will be more economical for the PRI subscriber and will provide more flexibility by allowing the customer to select which specific telephone numbers require 9-1-1 PinPoint service.
